U. S. CRUISER MAINE.

Last Wednesday, the United States

cruiser Maine, while lying at anchor in

Havana harbor was blown up, with loss

of life. Secretary Long of the Navy

received the following detailed despatch

from Captain Sigsbee, the commander of

the destroyed Maine:

'Advised sending wrecking vessel at

once. Maine submerged except debris;

mostly work for divers now. Jenkins

and Merritt still missing. Little hope

of their safety. Those known to be

saved are officers, 24, unharmed; crew,

18. Wounded now on board Ward line

steamer and in the city hospital and at

hotel, 59, so far as is known. All other

went lost or missing. 235. With gener-

al exceptions no officer or man has more

than a part of a suit of clothing, and

that is wet with harbor water. The

damage was in the compartment of the

crew. Am preparing to telegraph list of

wounded and saved. Will send all

wounded men to the hospital at Havana.
