An Act to afford relief to Trustees, Executors, and Administrators.

HER Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. Trustees, Executors, and Administrators, may charge and recover for their services in like manner as Agents in ordinary cases. Payment.

II. They may resign their respective offices as herein mentioned. Resignation.

III. Before resigning they shall publish a notice of such their intention in some Provincial Newspaper, where the estate or cestui que trust or party resigning resides, or as near thereto as convenient, for two calendar months; after which a resignation shall be filed, in the case of Trustees in Chancery, and in the case of Executors or Administrators in the Court from which Letters Probate or of Administration issued. Notice before resigning.

IV. They shall be liable to account, as in ordinary cases. Accounting.

V. The Court in which the resignation is filed shall appoint another or others in the place of those resigning. Appointment of others in their stead.
