An Act to amend the Act 18 Victoria, cap. 104.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act 18 Victoria, cap. 104: Preamble.
Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh sections of the said Act shall not apply to the appealable cases mentioned in the said Act, except by and with the consent in writing of all the parties to the said cases.

Certain sections to apply only by contract of parties.

II. If the said parties shall not consent to proceed in the said cases according to the provisions of the said sections, it shall be lawful for them to proceed with respect to proceedings in the said cases in accordance with the provisions of the laws in force immediately before the passing of the Act hereby amended, which said laws are hereby revived in so far as they may have been repealed or amended by the first above herein recited Act.

If not the proceedings shall be as before the passing of the said Act.
