Four black colonies, in Mr. Lockwood's apary, gave 93, 70, 65 and 55 pounds each; the best Italian 45 lbs. I made a fair test (they were all about equal in all points) and the blacks made a fine score and fairly bright yellow honey.

Mr. Lockwood is preparing to move his bees from his farm to the grounds of his new residence in this place, where he will form one of the most conveniently arranged apiaries. Mrs. Lockwood is decorating her fine home with a collection of house plants and flowering shrubbery which will eventually add to the appearance of the apary, when all is complete.
