The usefulness of the hospital could not fail to strike the heathen; to outdo the Christians, the Emperor Julian (361-363), ordered that hospitals should be built in all cities, but these pagan institutions were of short duration; they were not built on the foundation of love.

Of great celebrity was the hospital which St. Basil erected, mostly from charitable contributions, in the year 369 at Caesarea; it was built round the church, and consisted of many well arranged rooms for strangers, for sick and infirm, for physicians and attendants, and workshops for poor artisans; a special division was for the lepers, whom the saint would often nurse with his own hands.

The whole establishment looked like a small town, and St. Gregory, of Nazianz, counted it among the greatest works of human skill and organization, surpassing in usefulness by far the pyramids of Egypt, the colosseum at Rome, and other world-known monuments of the past.
