JUNIOR DEPARTMENT.

Pupils in this Department are prepared for the University, or for Commercial life—those Pupils whose Parents do not wish them to go through a Classical course, being specially instructed in Book-Keeping and Commercial Arithmetic.

FRENCH is taught throughout the School, not as an Extra, but in the regular course.

There is a Boarding Establishment under the charge of the Bursar, attached to the Department, for the convenience of Parents residing at a distance.

All fees to be paid in advance to the Bursar of the College.

The Council desires to draw the attention of Parents to the following regulations:

1. No absence is allowed from School without the express permission of the Rector, except for illness; in case of illness a written communication is required upon the return of the pupil.

2. At the commencement of each Term the Pupils are required to present a certificate from the Bursar that all dues have been settled for the previous term.

3. Pupils who are absent during any parts of the stated periods of residence, will be liable to the whole charge for Tuition; but will have remitted to them three-fourths of the charge for Board, if their absence exceeds one week.

The Rector, the Bursar, Professor Roux, and Mr. Capel, are prepared to receive a limited number of pupils each in their families.
