An Act to repeal in part an Act passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty reign, intituled " An Act to pro-" vide a remedy against the Corporation of the City of " Quebec in case of injury to property by any mob, or " during riots in the said City."

WHEREAS by the fourth clause or section of an Act passed in the Preamble last Session of the Logislature shows VV last Session of the Legislature, chapter two hundred and thirty-three, intituled "An Act to provide a remedy against the Corporation of 16 Via . 288:
