Coffee and Coffee Substitutes.

OTTAWA, Oct. 3, 1914.

SIR,—I have the honour to hand you a report upon three hundred and thirty-nine (339) samples procured throughout the Dominion by our food inspectors in November, December and January last.

These have been supplied on demand for *Coffee*, or *Coffee Substitutes*. *Coffee Substitutes* are usually compounds consisting of varying percentages of Coffee with chicory or roasted grain or peas, or mixtures of these. Thirty samples (30) sold as coffee substitutes contain no coffee. The following is the record for articles sold as Coffee Substitutes.

Consisting of Coffee and Chicory	12 samples.
“ “ “ and cereals	24 samples.
“ roasted cereals only	30 samples.
Total	66 samples.

The articles mentioned are properly sold as coffee substitutes; or by such description of each as shall inform the purchaser fully regarding the article supplied to him.

Thirteen samples (13) are so-called Extracts of Coffee. Most of these contain the soluble matter of chicory; but as this collection was specially directed to examination of the solid article, a detailed study of Coffee Extracts is left for a later report. For the same reason no work has been done upon 5 samples of so-called Condensed Coffees, which were collected through mistakes on the part of our inspectors.

One hundred and ninety-nine (199) samples, sold as coffee, are found to be true to name, and are described as genuine in this report.

There remain fifty-six (56) samples to be considered. All of these were supplied to the inspector on a demand for *Coffee*. In eight (8) cases the amount of foreign matter is so small that it is reasonable to explain its presence as accidental. Very frequently the same mill is used in grinding alternately a pure coffee and a mixture, and in this way a trace of chicory may find its way into a sample intended to be coffee only. I have marked such cases as “doubtful”.

In forty-nine (49) instances notable amounts of foreign matter are present in samples offered as Coffee. This, of course, constitutes adulteration, and all these cases are judged to be adulterated in the sense that they contain foreign material, not declared by the vendor.

Among the defences set up by vendors of these articles the only one which can be recognized as having any validity is that many users of coffee prefer to have a small amount of chicory in their coffee, and have been known to complain of the unsatisfactory character (to them) of the article when it did not contain chicory. The retail dealer, claims that he is required to add a small percentage of chicory in order to please his customers, and he becomes so habituated to supplying coffee mixed with chicory that he frequently forgets to mention the presence of this substance.

This defence may be given some weight when a small percentage of chicory only is found. It is not, however, valid in law, and dealers must recognize that when coffee is asked for, only coffee should be supplied.

Of the Forty nine (49) samples in which foreign matter has been found, Nineteen (19) samples contain chicory only, and in the following (minimum) amounts. Owing to variability in the quality of chicory it is not possible to define exactly the amount added; and the amounts named below must be understood to mean that at least the percentage quoted has been added.

The defence referred to may perhaps be granted some force up to 5 or possibly up to 10 per cent, chicory; but it is certainly not to be taken seriously when more than 10 per cent of chicory is present, without statement of the fact, as in eight (8) samples noted.

Thirty samples (30) of the forty-nine judged to be adulterated, contain roasted cereals, with or without chicory, as an adulterant. It is certain that no purchaser of coffee wishes roasted grain or roasted peas to be mixed with the article. The amounts of foreign matter in these Thirty (30) samples are found to be as follows:

It has been clearly shown in many cases that the manufacturer supplied these articles to the retail vendor as mixtures or compounds, properly labelled; and at prices which could not but make the purchaser aware that he was dealing with a mixture. In all such cases, the responsibility rests with the retail vendor, who should have warned the customer that an article which was not pure coffee was being offered him. It would then remain for the purchaser to express his consent to the transaction, which would thus become legal. Otherwise, the purchaser is clearly defrauded, and the vendor makes himself *amenable* to a charge of selling adulterated goods.

A special variation occurs where the manufacturer offers an article with a specific name or brand, but without an explicit statement on the label or on his invoice to show that the article contains chicory or roasted grain. Usually the low price at which such an article is furnished gives the retail dealer to know that something other than pure coffee is present. In such case, should the retail dealer be under the impression that he was handling genuine coffee, he would of course be morally guiltless. Whether or not he could be held legally blameless would depend upon his having a warranty of genuineness as provided in Section 33 of the Act.

I beg to recommend publication of this report as Bulletin No. 290.
