THE YUKON SCANDAL.

The Globe considers the charges made by Mr. Angus A. McKenzie against the Yukon officials serious enough to demand editorial criticism. These charges, it will be remembered, were contained in a letter written by Mr. McKenzie from Dawson City to his brother, who resides in Kincaidville. The Globe thinks the charges are worthless because the names of none of the offending officials are given so far as the letter itself goes, it leaves every evidence of truthfulness. The language is that of a man who has suffered a grievous wrong, who feels that he has been badly treated. He writes to his mother, as anyone would naturally do, to relieve his feelings. Every word of the letter bears the impress of truth. As for enough to demand editorial criticism by name, why should he do it in such a letter? No one, under the circumstances, would think it a relevant part of his story to supply a list of names of officials of whom the recipient of the letter would be completely ignorant. The omission which the Globe does not fail to do the work of detract from the credibility of the writer. The principal point about the publication of this letter is that it discloses the name of a man who makes charges which The Globe admits are "of the gravest character." The man who makes them was recently residing in this province, well known in the district where he resided. He has relatives living in this city. He is not a Yankee, but a Canadian, a man of good reputation, and, furthermore, he belongs to a dyed-in-the-wool family of Liberals. The Government's fear, under the circumstances, is not the light of the charges, no names have been specified, but to follow Mr. McKenzie up and obtain from him all the particulars in his possession relating to the case.
