Butterfield Expected to be Reached Friday - A Canadian's Force at the Crossing - Death of One of the Half-Breeds - The Return to Winnipeg.

OTTAWA, April 22. - This afternoon John Macdonald said the government has no official information of the massacre at Fort Pitt, but so many reports from the west have reached this city that he is sure that at least 200 men were killed, although as yet only 70 were reported to have been killed.
