President Withrow Talks About the Recent Remarks to the Affairs of the Association—Nearly All the Old Board Elected.

Never during the ten years of its existence has the Industrial Exhibition Association of Toronto held a more important annual meeting than that which was held yesterday afternoon in the City Council Chamber.

To reduce the free admission. The profits, represented by the assets, having increased from \$20,673 in 1879 to \$96,383 in 1888, over and above all liabilities, and having been accumulating for ten years without anything being written off, it was recommended that before the next annual statement is prepared, a valuation of all the buildings and properties owned by the association be made, and a proper proportion be written off.

As a proof that the accounts ought to be well looked after, Mr. Withrow mentioned that one of the auditors of the year 1888, the debt is now reduced to \$5000, and in the last ten years they have erected nearly \$100,000 worth of buildings.

Mr. Withrow urged the necessity of new stabling and increased accommodation, in the management for the last ten years the Exhibition Association has never taken one cent of the taxes of the city to help it, because it had no arrangement that the proceeds of certain lands set apart for the purpose of the city's contribution. In the past they have been mismanaged and now the time is clear to see.
