



CONSTITUTION  
OF THE  
Kritosophian Club of Yarmouth, Nova Scotia.

---

ARTICLE I.

This Club shall be known as the KRITOSOPHIAN CLUB OF YARMOUTH,  
NOVA SCOTIA.

ARTICLE II.

The Kritosophian Club shall have for its object the intellectual improvement of its members.

ARTICLE III.

The officers shall be a President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer, elected at the business meeting, who with a Programme Committee of three, shall form the Executive.

ARTICLE IV.

The duties of the officers shall commence at the September meeting following their election.

ARTICLE V.

The Programme Committee shall hold office from their election until such time as the work which they have arranged shall be completed.

## BY-LAWS.

1. The regular meetings of the Kritosophian Club shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month, with the exception of July and August. The Annual Business Meeting shall be held the fourth Tuesday in March.
2. A Special Meeting of the Club may be called at any time by the President or at the request of any three members.
3. (a) The membership shall at no time exceed thirty.  
(b) Seven members shall constitute a Quorum.
4. That interest may be sustained it is hereby enacted that, unless prevented by sickness, absence from Yarmouth, or any other unavoidable circumstance, no member shall be absent from the regular meetings of the Club for more than four consecutive evenings without forfeiting membership.
5. Proposals for membership shall be made in writing and signed by seven members of the Club; these shall be regularly filed by the Secretary, and as vacancies occur they shall be filled in the order in which the accepted names stand.
6. The Leaders for the year shall be chosen in alphabetical order, but may have a choice of their meeting. Any leader not wishing to act shall procure a substitute.
7. The Annual Membership Fee shall be fifty cents, payable in September.
8. By a two-thirds vote at any regular meeting these articles and by-laws may be amended, provided notice of such change be given at a previous meeting.
9. A member, who has for sufficient reason, withdrawn from the Club, may at her request, be reinstated by acclamation, provided there is a vacancy.
