## CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

## ontario.

Lumber manufacturers and dealers are apparently satisfied with the volume of business they are doing; it is quite up to the averase for this season of the year, with indicutions of much more attivity in a week or iwo as a resuit of the commencementof spring building operations. The q̧uantity of lumber required for building purposes is expected to be greater than last year, and with ar, average consumption by manufac uring industries, a good seasnn's trade at satisfactory prices is looked for. In Ottawa the buildings comrriericed and under contemplation are chiefly of the cheaper class, calling for the lower grades of lumber. As a result of a by-law passed in Oltawn some time ago preventing the use of wooden shingles on houses, the local demand for shingles is extremely quiel, but a good enquiry is reported from outside points. In the Georgian Bay district sates of pine mill culls are being made at $\$ 10.50$ and $\$ 11$ at the mill. Michigan dealers a e lcoking to Georgian Bay points to supp y a considerable quantity of the stock required for the cG:ming season.
There is some irregularity in hardwood prices, and the market is not as firm as might be wished for. In Toronto some dealers are asking $\$ 24$ for first and second black ash, I and $1 / 1 / 2$ meh, which others are quosing at $\$ 22$. Mill run is selling at $\$ 18$, with $\$ 20$ asked in exceptional cases. There is practicatly no basswood offering in firsts and seconds, but from $\$_{20}$ to $\$_{22}$ could be realized for good sinck. Miil run basswood is selling at $\$ 17$.
gurbec and new mounswick.
Influenced by favorable reports from the Eastern Stypes, the spruce lumber market is showing nore strength. Manufacturersare looking forward to an active demand from the United States and to a considerable consumption of lumber for local purpeses, paticularly of the cheaper grades. While the price of clapboards is nominally unchanged, the supply is so small that if there should arise even a moderate demand, it would be reflected in higher prices. The supply of New Brunswick cedar shingles is like wise small. Sellers are asking $\$ 3$ for extras, $\$ 2.65$ for clears, and $\$ 2.20$ for sec-
ond clears, Boston rate of treight, although sales are being.made by small manufacturers about five cents less.

LEI United staths.
A mos! satisfactory volume of business for the past week is reported from the white pine producing points. :ir the Ash. land and Duluth districts the buying by wholesale dealers has been quite active, and mosi of the stock is now held \$1 to $\$ 1.50$ higher than last fall. Sales of No. 3 boards are being made at $\$ 12.75$, and some manufacturers are holding out for Siz for the coming season's cut of that grade. This is about $\$_{i}$ in advance of the price at which this grade was sold tast summer, and shows the steady ap. preciation in the value of pine lumber. The feeling in the Lake Superior district is that the spring will bring forth a sharp demand for lumber, and that the year will be one of general prosperity for the lumber trade. Indications are that the cut of $l_{i} s$ for the mills of Duluth-Supertor will be net more than $390.000,000$ feet, as compared with $425,000,000$ feet last win'er. Buyers in the east are apparently convinced that there will be no break in prices, and are therefore placing contracts for their supply of lumber. In the Chicago market there is a scarcity of No. 1 and No. 212 -inch boards, and piece stuff is none too plentiful. Both white and Norway pine piece stuff is selling at $\$ 14.50$ to $\$ 15$ for short lengths f.o.b. cars Chicago. Tonawanda trade is more settled, with less cutung of prices on the coarser graces. Good lumber seems to be most wanted in the east, although some demand has developed for box lumber.
There is no perceptible improvement in the call for hardwoods. The better grades are s-lling more freely than cheap lumber, but the large consumets are apparently keeping out of the market as long as possible. Maple is showing more strength, while birch and elm are weak. Basswood still leads both in point of de. mand and scaısity of supply.

## great mbitain:

The IBratish timber market continues to be somewhat unsellled. Swedish shippers are firm in their prices for deals, but the White Sea exporters are said to be offering to accept a reduction of ten shillings per standard from late asking prices. This has led importers to look for a general decline in puecs, and consequently buying is at a stindsill. So far as Canadian deals are concerned, however, the market seems to be steady, al-
though the reports are rather contradictory. From one source of information it is learned that pine and spruce deals have been sold heavily at high prices, while another report states that contracting in pine goods for the coming season has been on an unusually restricted scale. The most reliable advice is to the effect that the quantity of pine and spruce placed with imporiers is slightly less than last senson. Concerning spruce deals at Liverpool, a correspondent says: "The stock in this market is heavy, and the large shipments that have been coming forward have upset the calculation of a good nany with regard to this class of timber. It would be an advantage to the trade generally if the import could be restricted, as sales are being made at low prices, and a weakening effect is the result."

At Cleveland there is a scarcity of lath. No. : white pine is selling at $\$ 4$, No. 2 white pine at $\$_{3} \cdot 50$, and bemlock at $\$_{3}$. The demand from country yards is fully one-third greater than at the same time last ycar.
The sale of the simber on Grand laland, in Haliburton county, is reported. Seven hundred acres are included in the deal, by whicl the Standard Chemical Company of Fenclon Falls, get the maple, bireh and be ch, the Rathbun Company the cedar. ine, hemlock, and T. I. DeCew \& Sons, Fenelon Falls, the elm, ash and hasswood.
