The Main Issue First. An apology is due to our general readers for the ADVANCE being devoted so largely as it has been, for the past two weeks, to the North Shore lumber interests.

Mr. Blair: Do you feel yourself in position to establish that there is really a substantial difference between the prices of lumber in the North Shore and in the southern portion of the Province?

THE STAMPAGE QUESTION. We published last week a report of proceedings at the Convention of 3rd inst. at Fredericton, between a committee representing the Government and one representing North Shore Lumber interests.
