## GENERAL NEWS.

A female parachutist fell 500 feet

from a balloon at Berlin last week and

was instantly killed.

It was a clergyman of Lincolnshire,

England, the Rev. Mr. Anket, who, in

the year 1698, first gave the germ of

thought of life insurance.

A heavy shock of earthquake was

felt in various parts of California last

Monday. Serious eruptions took place

in Greece that day.

Ex-Premier Marcell's creditors met

on Tuesday, but adjourned to enable the

fallen statesman to make some offer of

compromise. The state is likely to run

out better than was expected, assets be-

ing \$55,000 and liabilities \$61,000.

Charles White, an aeronaut, fell

1,500 feet from a balloon near Baltimore

on Sunday, and landed in a corn field.

He was picked up unconscious, but the

doctors say no bones are broken.

Africa is being rapidly taken pos-

session of. Its total area is 11,514,000

square miles, and its population 130,-

181,000. Its great Great Britain has

the largest share owning 2,970,000 acres

with a population of 40,764,000.

The French ministry of war has been

engaged for more than a year in making

experiments in the preservation of meat.

The experiments have resulted in the

discovery that meat can be kept for

eight months without any change in its

appearance or powers of nourishment.

There are several instances on re-

cord of the complete destruction of

whole regiments in one battle. On Septem-

ber 6, 1812, Napoleon's Fifty-third

regiment perished to a man in storming

the Roman positions. On January

6, 1842, only 65 out of 14,500 British

soldiers emerged alive at a battle fought

near Jaggidull. In November, 1883,

the whole army of Hicks Pasha, 11,000

strong, was cut to pieces near the fifth

cataract of the River Nile.
