THE EMBARGO ON CANADIAN CATTLE

By a Bare Majority of Two

Mr. C. G. Russell, Parliamentary Secretary of the India Office, replied that the proposals relating to taxation in India would be announced in the annual budget.

The proposals for the coming year had not been definitely fixed.

Replying to questions on the subject Sir William Vernon Harcourt, Chancellor of the Exchequer, declared that he was not intended to open the mint nor to adopt the free coinage of silver nor to re-adopt a minimum rate for the sale of Indian gold.

The Government did not intend to import gold or to change its present policy.

The Government has not exhausted its borrowing powers, being inside of the limit of £20,000,000 sterling.

AFTERMATH OF THE STORM.

Thirty Deaths in Oklahoma—Loss of Life and Damage to Property in Germany.

KANSAS CITY, Feb. 13.—Reports received here today from Oklahoma and the Indian Territory make it almost certain that at least 30 lives were lost during the great storm of Sunday. Many isolated homesteads where the families were poorly prepared for the winter cannot be heard from for days and possibly weeks, and there is reason to believe 50 will not represent the number of the dead.

Besides two families reported from near Cross an unknown man was found near Stillwater a man was frozen to death under his house and south of Cleveland in County Atoka a man was reported to have been found dead in a hut. Near Andarkas three Indian children, who were caught out in the storm, died. The number of dead cattle will reach thousands.

EL RENO, O. T., Feb. 13.—Three Indian school children lost their lives in the heavy snow and perished Saturday night. In Alta more than 100 head of horses and cattle were frozen.

Mrs. Jennie Johnston, a young Indian teacher, was caught in the blizzard and died from exposure.

Many Fatalities in Germany.

BERLIN, Feb. 13.—Reports of loss of life and damage to property yesterday's storm continue to be received from all parts of the country.

At Ragnitz a scaffolding upon which a number of men were working was blown down and four of the workmen were instantly killed and a number injured.

In a house was blown down and all the inmates were buried in the ruins. The debris was soon cleared away, when it was found that the chimney had either been crushed to death or suffocated.

At Rinteln the chimney of the Stove and Glass Works was blown away and some of the workmen struck three persons killing them instantly.

At Sonderburg a bridge collapsed and several persons were killed.

A CONVICTED OPIMUM SMOGLER Will Spend Two Years in Jail and Pay a Fine of £100.

PORTLAND, Ore., Feb. 13.—William Dunbar, one of the principals in the great smuggling ring of the Northwest, who was convicted in December, was sentenced today on an indictment containing six counts for smuggling opium to two years in the County Jail and fined \$100.
