REPORT OF PROCEEDINGS
OF THE
CENTRAL GENERAL COMMITTEE,
OTTAWA FIRE RELIEF FUND,

From 22nd August, 1870 to 28th July 1871.

In making this Report, the Committee are quite aware that it is due to those who came forward in the time of need, and shewed their sympathy by subscribing largely to the Fund, that a full Statement of all the Proceedings should be given; but as full particulars of each Meeting, and all that has been done by the Committee, would entail a large amount of expense in printing, they have decided that a detailed Summary of the Receipts and Expenditure only should be given, and that abstracts of their Proceedings should be compiled from the Minute Book,—so that whilst the Report should be as brief as possible, all essential information should be furnished.

A meeting of the citizens of Ottawa was called by Ald. Featherston, acting Mayor, for Monday the 22nd August, at the City Hall, to express sympathy for the sufferers by the great fires of the past week, in the Counties of Carleton and Ottawa, and in the Ottawa District generally, and to devise means to alleviate the distress occasioned thereby.

The citizens generally nobly responded to the call and attended in large numbers, and when the meeting was opened, there were present amongst others, Parliamentary representatives, Members of the Dominion Government, Aldermen of the City, Mill owners from the Chaudiere, and leading citizens generally.

J. M. Currier, Esq., M. P., was appointed Chairman, and James Cunningham, Esq., was requested to act as Secretary.

The Chairman having briefly explained the object of the meeting, the following Resolutions were moved and seconded by the respective parties and carried unanimously:—

1. Moved by Mr. Sheriff Powell, and seconded by Robert Lyon, Esq., M.P.P.;

“That this meeting, deploring the terrible calamity that has desolated, and is still desolating a large portion of this section of country, would appeal to a generous public for aid for the sufferers, many of whom have been in an hour reduced from comparative affluence to absolute want.”

2. Moved by Judge Armstrong, and seconded by George Hay, Esq.;

“That the Chairman be authorized to communicate with the Local Governments of Ontario and Quebec, asking assistance at their hands to meet this unhappy emergency.”

3. Moved by Alexander Workman, Esq., and seconded by Edward McGillivray, Esq.;

“That the Mayor and Corporation of this City be requested by this Meeting, composed of citizens and rate-payers, to hold a Special Meeting, and to appropriate an additional sum of money not less than \$5,000, towards the sufferers by the fire, wherever they may be found.”

4. Moved by Alonzo Wright, Esq., M.P., and seconded by Dr. Grant, M.P.;

“That this meeting would suggest the immediate convening of the County Councils of Carleton, Ottawa, and Prescott and Russell, and the appropriation of a liberal vote by these bodies in aid of the sufferers.”

5. Moved by Dr. Sweetland and seconded by Thomas McKay, Esq.;

“That a Central Committee be appointed, for the purpose of collecting subscriptions in aid of the sufferers by the present calamity, and adopting such means as they may deem necessary toward carrying out in the most effectual way all that can be done towards their relief, and that the following gentlemen do compose said Committee, viz. —J. M. Currier, M. P., R. W. Scott, M.P.P., The Hon. James Skead, R. Lyon, M.P.P., Dr. Hill, Sheriff Powell, Dr. Grant, M.P., Alonzo Wright, M.P., Dr. Sweetland, H. N. Bate, H. V. Noel, J. Durie, F. Clemow, P. A. Egleson, G. & S. Church, Wm. Smillie, John Mather,

James Rochester, N. Sparks, E. McGillivray, Thos. Hunton, W. McKay Wright, J. T. Pennock, J. Holmes, M.P., R. Blackburn, Ira Morgan, A. Mutchmor, James Wadsworth, Thomas Patterson, N. 6. Moved by Thos. Hunton, and seconded by Dr. Garvey;

"That a Subscription List be opened forthwith in order to afford those present an opportunity of subscribing."

The movers and seconders of each resolution, as well as the Honorable Sir Francis Hincks, Honorable Alex. Morris, Mr. Marshall, (of England,) and Ira Morgan, Esq., Warden of the County of Carleton, spoke in most eloquent and burning terms, in reference to the object of the meeting and the subject matter of the foregoing resolutions.

A subscription list having been opened, the munificent sum of \$9,799 00 was subscribed then and there, and the meeting adjourned.

The General Committee met immediately after the close of the Public Meeting in the City Hall, on Monday the 22nd August, A.D. 1870, when, upon motion of John Durie, Esq., seconded by J. Fraser, J. M. Currier, Esq., M.P. was appointed Chairman of Committee. Upon motion of Dr. Grant, M.P., seconded by James Wadsworth, Esq., James Cunningham, Esq. was appointed Treasurer, and upon motion of W. McKay

Wright, Esq., seconded by John Durie, Esq., James Fraser was appointed Secretary.

Gentlemen were duly appointed to solicit subscriptions in the several Wards of the City as follows:—

Sub-Committees were appointed to investigate and report on the losses as well as the condition of the sufferers, in the Counties of Ottawa and Carleton respectively. The Gentlemen thus appointed performed the duty assigned them in a most creditable manner.

The unanimity which existed amongst the members thereof was most creditable; all were most anxious to provide as liberally as possible for those who suffered by the great calamity; the latter generally deserve the greatest encouragement for the brave manner in which they bore their terrible loss and for the energy displayed by them in restoring as far as possible a home or shelter before the cold inclement Winter had fairly set in. There are doubtless many references which ought to be embodied in this Report, which the Committee would like to see published, but owing to the length which it has already attained they refrain from making them; however they beg to tender their thanks to the Members of the Dominion Government for the countenance and support given by them, and for their individual subscriptions, also to the Minister of Militia for the loan of fifty tents which were distributed amongst the houseless, for temporary shelter; also to the Governments and Legislatures of the Provinces of Ontario and Quebec respectively, for their Grants; also to all those who in any way contributed to the relief of the sufferers, either in money, clothing, blankets, food or otherwise; also to the Press of the Dominion, for their many kindly articles which appeared in reference to the great conflagration, and for the urgent appeals on behalf of the sufferers therefrom. To the ladies especially do the Committee feel grateful for the manner in which they provided for the female portion of the sufferers, in under-clothing and useful garments. In conclusion, the Committee beg to state that it is most gratifying to them to hear such encouraging accounts of the growing crops throughout this section of the country, and especially from those portions of it that were so fearfully devastated on the 17th August 1870.
