President's Remarks. Gentlemen—In submitting for your approval the statements just read, I have pleasure in pointing out that the results for 1905 are well up to the standard of former years, and make a very satisfactory showing.

As against an income from premiums in 1904 of \$223,875.77, the 1905 business and renewals reached a considerable sum of \$252,290.57, in round figures a quarter of a million dollars. During the year 2165 persons received benefits under the Company's policies, the payments aggregating \$118,729.57, and it may be noted that the claims exceeded six daily for every working day of the year.

CONTROLLERS SHAW AND JONES FOR COURT OF REVISION

City Council Must Decide—Island Committee Report Returned—Budget From City Hall.

Wm. F. Ardagh was yesterday nominated by the board of control for the position on the court of revision rendered vacant by the death of Thomas Bryce some months ago. He is well-known in Conservative circles, and was supported by the mayor and Controller Shaw and Jones. Controller Ward nominated John Irving, who had the qualification of having been controller with the assessment department for twenty years, but was out-voted. Controller Hubbard was not in the hall at the time it is a matter which the act provides the council must deal with. There are eighteen applicants for the position. Controller Jones nominated Mr. Smith and Controller Ward also nominated Frank Moses and Mr. Traxton, but the names were rejected and the others were not mentioned.

Mayor's Mysterious Letter.
The mayor has a mysterious letter from President Mackenzie which was passed around silently among the members of the board of control yesterday. It is said to be an assurance that the Toronto Railway Company will carry out the terms of agreement in regard to the loops and extensions.

The issue of penalty writs against the Toronto Railway Company has not ceased. This information was given to Ald. Graham who asked if the board of control, who also said the other members of the board in regard to this matter had not been disregarded by the legal department.

Assistant Engineer Johnston of Halifax, N.S., and Manager Grosby of the Halifax Street Railway called upon Engineer Rust yesterday and talked with him about paying track allowances. They want to discuss the best method and have been examining the tracks in Toronto. Although we have had troubles here outside city limits, we have done pretty well with the problem.

WARD WILL BE HEARD

The Island committee's recommendation, that the services of Island Controller Ward be discontinued, was backed by the board of control in order that Mr. Ward might have an opportunity of addressing the council in his own behalf. Controller Hubbard testified to Ward's Heavens record. The chief issue was the fact that Churches should pay the same rate as anybody else, Controller Hubbard thinks and the island committee's recommendation, that a west end congregation at Hanlan's Point should have a site for two-one year at \$25 a year, was sent back to the committee by the board of control. The church property would be exempt from taxation.

Ald. Ward voted against the motion of inserting a \$2 a day minimum wage clause in civic contracts. The city solicitor could the clause be inserted, but the mayor and Controller Hubbard, Shaw and Jones were against it. The matter will however, come up again in council.

That Tussock Moth.
The board decided that the legislature should be asked for a law that would allow the parks commissioner to enter upon private property and spray trees upon which tussock moth and cocoons are found, and a nominal charge made against the owner of the trees.

The shares are \$50 each. Already there are thirty-eight shareholders subscribed, and good prospects of many more. The poles for the line are ordered, and the work of constructing the line will be proceeded with as soon as the spring season had been paid him in operation by the first of May.

PAARDEBERG IN PICTURE EXHIBITION BOARD HAS ONE

Plans Are Also Adopted for New Press and Horticultural Buildings.

Writes the managing director of art at the Guild Hall, London: "It is a matter of great gratification to myself and co-directors that this picture—The

Surrender of Paardeberg—which was painted by the brave Canadian troops, is to find its permanent home amidst those it endeavors to honor, and I hope that for all time it will stand as an incentive to the youth of the Dominion for generations to come as a demonstration of what patriotism for the motherland will produce in times of danger." The picture referred to is one of two by the famous war artist, Caton Woodville, bought by the directors of the Canadian National Exhibition for the art gallery, the other being "The Dawn of Majuba Day," and the total cost \$2000. At the meeting of the directors at which this purchase was approved, letters were read from the secretaries of various institutions in England and the continent of Europe acknowledging presents of albums

containing views of the city and the exhibition; also from the Eastern Passenger Association, saying the excursion rates would be given this year as last with the difference that they would start four days earlier so that exhibitors might take advantage of them. Plans for a new press bureau and a horticultural building were submitted by Architect George W. Gouinlock and approved. The former calls for a building 70 ft. x 40 ft. to be located in the centre of the grounds with press rooms below and lavatories, waiting rooms and committee rooms above. Its cost will be \$25,000. The horticultural building, the cost of which will be \$70,000, will be on a far more ambitious scale. It will be in the form of a cross, the extremes of which will be 120 feet apart. Each will be devoted to a separate department, name-

ly, fruit, flowers, vegetables and honey. In the centre will be a glass dome, rising to a height of 65 feet. The structure will be decidedly ornate in character, and will present an imposing appearance.

May Be a Murder. The police suspect that Chas. Rowe of New Haven, Conn., an advertising solicitor, was poisoned.

His body was found yesterday in front of 261 Amsterdam-avenue, and there were indications that the body had been dragged from a nearby ally. Rowe arrived last Wednesday with several hundred dollars in his possession.

ONE DAY FOR DEPUTATIONS GOVERNMENT IS TOO BUSY

Six More Municipalities Candidates to Be Established.

The premier has put a stopper on the deputations. Half a dozen, or more, have been crowding his time and that of his ministers every day. He handed out the following statement on Friday: "The number of deputations calling upon the government, since the opening of the legislature has been so great that the ministers have been unable to do little but their departmental work. Consequently, the cabinet has decided that outside of interviews already arranged, no deputations will be received on Thursday of next week and thereafter on Wednesday of each week during the session, and on no other days. The adoption of this course is absolutely necessary in order to allow the ministers time to give even partial attention to their duties."

Three deputations were received by Hon. Dr. Frye yesterday afternoon. Samia is an applicant for one of the proposed normal schools and a deputations to the legislature was introduced by Hugh Montgomery, the member for East Lambton. The claims of Samia, Mrs. Harris were urged by H. Flynn, ex-mayor, C. N. Smith, the 800 member, and W. R. Smyth, member for Algoma. Cornwall also after one deputations from that town having been introduced, by George Kerr, M. P.

During the morning there were deputations with the same object from Guelph, Galt and Hamilton. The first named, introduced by J. P. Downey, M. P., included Mayor, Cressman, Aid, Neudart, President Cressman of the O. A. C., and representatives of the school board and the county council. From Galt came Geo. A. Clare, M. P. for South Waterloo; Mayor Thomson, and various others. Mr. Atkinson, M. P. for South Waterloo, ushering them.

LIABLE TO SUSPENSION Vienna, Feb. 23.—Five bills embodying a scheme for universal suffrage and other electoral reforms were introduced in the lower house of the Austrian parliament to-day by the premier, Baron Gausch von Frankenthurn.

The premier was subjected to a heavy interruption on the part of Pan-Germans while explaining the details of the plan, but the majority of the bill, which hearty applauded his speech, a bill amending the standing orders of the house provides for the suspension of disorderly members for a period not exceeding one week.
