**THE U. S. CONGRESS.**

**Secretary Foster Presents His Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure.**  
WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 7.—Secretary Foster in his annual report estimates the total revenue for present fiscal year ending June 30, 1893, at \$468,350,350 and expenditures for the same period at \$461,336,350, leaving an estimated surplus of \$7,014,000. It is estimated the cash balance available on June 30, 1893, will be \$120,992,377; that the revenues of the Government for the fiscal year 1894 will be \$490,121,365, total estimated appropriations exclusive of a sinking fund of \$47,461,335, or an estimated surplus of \$32,660,030, to which add cash balance above gold reserve, making an estimated available balance of \$33,852,407, from which deduct accrued accruing obligations estimated at \$3,000,000, leaving \$30,852,407.

"Public opinion having decreed a change of policy," says Secretary Foster, "the conditions resulting therefrom render it impossible at the present time to estimate the annual income with any degree of accuracy, and it is impossible to predict the effect that such a change would have upon the future revenues of the Government. Under all the circumstances it would be inappropriate in me to make an estimate other than as already stated; but it is not out of place to remark that the business community, having a full knowledge of tariff reductions, the inevitable result will be a falling off in importations and a corresponding decrease in the revenues. The extent of this decrease no one will be able to measure until business shall again adjust itself to the new condition."

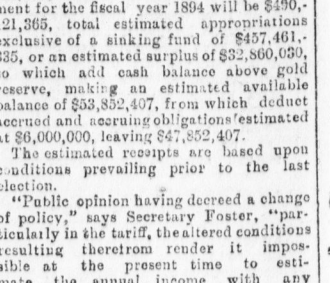
