An Act to amend the Act to amend the Judicature Acts of Lower Canada.

WHEREAS the inhabitants of the different Parishes in the County of Bellechasse have, by their petition represented, that the Act passed in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act to amend the Judicature Acts of Lower Canada," has the effect of rendering the administration of Justice in the said County less easy and more expensive to the inhabitants thereof than it was before the passing of the said Act: And whereas it is expedient to remedy this inconvenience; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The County of Bellechasse shall, from and after the passing of this Act, cease to form part of the Judicial District of Montmagny, and shall be annexed to the Judicial District of Quebec, anything in the said Act, intituled, "An Act to amend the Judicature Acts of Lower Canada," or in the Schedule A, annexed to the said Act, to the contrary notwithstanding; and the said last mentioned Act shall apply to the Judicial District of Quebec, as so enlarged, to all intents and purposes as though this Act and the said last mentioned Act, formed but one and the same Act.

II. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act.
