(From the London Telegraph, June 2.) About four o'clook yesterday afternoon, as Prince Edward of Sare Weimar was about to leave his house in Portland place to attend the levee at St. James Palace, and just as he had stepped on the pavement to enter his carriage, he was shot at by a man who had alighted from a sab that was standing on the opposite side of the road. The Prince was not aware of the man's presence till he heard the explosion; nor, indeed, does it appear that any one actually saw the shot fired or perceived that the man carried a pistol. Pursuing the Prince back into the house, the man forced his way nearly to the staircase before he found himself stopped from further intrusion. The servants, who probably had not heard the sound of a pistol shot, did not think of detaining him; he was allowed to re-enter the cab, in which was a little child, and the vehicle drove off without even the number having been taken by the bewildered domestics. The intruder is described as apparently a foreigner, of dark complexion, and so violent in his demeanour as to justify the belief that he is a madman.
