Following is the Activity Report for the quarter ending December 31, 1989. This report contains a synopsis of activities and results by sector and subsector reported by the missions in Latin America and Carribean matched against the proposed activities identified in their 1989/90 post plan. It also contains a report of special unplanned activities that took place during the report period.

The purpose of the report is to allow managers in Ottawa and abroad to monitor the progress of program implementation by comparing planned activities in priority sectors with reported quarterly activity highlights and results.

Readers will note that in some cases the section for post inputs for a particular quarter is blank. This occurs when the mission either has not yet undertaken any of the planned activities in that sector or has not reported activities in a sector identified as a priority in the post plan.

Voici le Rapport des activités du trimestre qui a pris fin le 31 décembre 1989. Le rapport contient un résumé des activités et des résultats déclarés par les missions en Amérique latine et Antilles, par secteur et sous-secteur, qui sont comparés aux projets d'activités indiqués dans les plans de missions de 1989/90. Il s'y trouve également un rapport sur les activités spéciales non planifiées qui ont été accomplies pendant la période visée.

Ce rapport a pour but de permettre aux gestionnaires, à Ottawa et à l'extérieur, de surveiller les progrès accomplis relativement à la mise en oeuvre du programme, en comparant les activités planifiées dans les secteurs prioritaires avec les faits saillants et les résultats déclarés du trimestre.

THE CONTINUATION OF THE "DRUG WAR" AND A RESURGENCE OF GUERRILLA ACTIVITY CONTINUE TO NEGATIVELY AFFECT COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES AND ARE REFLECTED IN THE RESULTS CONTAINED IN THIS REPORT. TRADE MISSIONS AND BUSINESS VISITS HAVE BEEN CANCELLED OR RESCHEDULED.

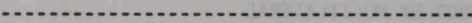
