CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE ELEVENTH SPECIAL SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, Dr. Mark MacGuigan, announced today that he will lead the Canadian Delegation to the Eleventh Special Session of the United Nations General Assembly, to be held in New York from August 25 to September 5. The principal issues for the Special Session will be the adoption of a new International Development Strategy for the 1980's and the launching of the Global Negotiations on international economic cooperation for development.
