




# A By-Law,

*To Transfer the authority vested in this Council over Roads  
Township Municipalities*

WHEREAS by a certain By-Law of this County Council, dated March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-four, it was provided that the several Township Municipalities, "prior to the passing of the said Act, should assume the responsibility of making, maintaining and repairing of County Roads bordering on such Municipalities. And as it appears from the said Act, and also from the Municipal Act, 1842, that it is necessary that all doubt and extent of the authority vested by this Council in the Township Municipalities, should be removed, by a more explicit delegation of the powers possessed by this Council, to the minor Municipalities.

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Warden and Municipal Council of the County of Norfolk in Municipal Council assembled, that from and after the passing of this By-Law, all authority now vested in, or possessed by, this Council, within the limits of the several Townships in this County, shall be and is hereby delegated to the Township Councils within the same, to be vested in the respective Township Councils within the same, to be performed; to be by the said several Township Councils, in such full and perfect a manner as could or might be done by this Council, if this By-Law had not been passed; anything in the said By-Law to the contrary notwithstanding.

The foregoing By-Law was passed in open Council, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 1844.
