BILL.

An Act to revive the Act of the Parliament of Upper Canada, incorporating the Niagara and Detroit Rivers Railroad Company.

WHEREAS it is expedient to revive the Act herein-
after mentioned, subject to the provisions herein-
after made: Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

That, subject to the limitations and provisions hereinafter
5 made, the Act of the Parliament of Upper Canada, passed
in the sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King
William the Fourth, and intituled, "*An Act to Incorporate*
certain persons therein mentioned, under the name and
style of the Niagara and Detroit Rivers Railroad
10 "*Company,*" shall be and is hereby revived, and shall
have force and effect as if herein repeated and re-enacted. Act of U. C. 6 W. 4. c. 6. revived.

II. Provided always and be it enacted, That the seven-
teenth section of the said Act shall be read and construed
as if herein re-enacted, so that the Company mentioned
15 in the said Act shall have two years from the passing of
this Act to commence the construction of their Railroad,
and ten years from the passing of this Act to construct,
finish and put in operation the whole of the said Railroad;
subject to the forfeiture of privileges in the said section
20 mentioned, if they shall fail to comply with the require-
ments thereof construed as aforesaid. How the 17th section shall be construed.

III. And be it enacted, That for and notwithstanding
any thing to the contrary in the sixteenth section, or
any other part of the said Act, the said Company shall
25 have full power to construct their Railroad from any point
on the Niagara River to any point on the Detroit River,
and that the said Road may be located accordingly by
Limits of the Road extended. Commissioners for locating the Railroad.

who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that pur-
pose, with the powers mentioned in the said sixteenth
30 section, which powers any of them may validly
exercise.

IV. And be it enacted, That
shall be Commissioners under the first section of the said Commissioners under section 1.

V. And be it enacted, That the said Railroad shall be subject to the provisions of any general Act relating to Railroads which may be passed by the Provincial Parli- 5
ament, and that all the provisions of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to make certain general provisions with regard to the services which the Government may require of Railroad Companies, whose Acts of Incorporation make them* 10
liable to such general provisions," shall apply to the said Company and to their Railroad.

VI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
