The rules for point scoring are as follows: Each team winning an event scores 20 points; each team losing an event scores 10 points; each team forfeiting an event loses 25 points.

METHOD

These events will take place in the enclosed part of the grounds.

1. Standing Broad Jump—No. 1 of each team will toe mark and jump; No. 2 of each team will start from the footprints of No. 1, and go on.

2. Shot Put without turn—If a man "puts" with his right arm he places his left foot on the mark. If No. 2 "puts" with his right arm he places his left foot on the mark left by the shot put by his team mate, and so on, or vice versa.

3. Throwing the 56-lb. Weight—No. 1 toes the mark and throws the weight forward directly from a swing between the legs; No. 2 stands directly over the mark left by the weight thrown by No. 1, and so on.

4. Standing Hop-Step-and-Jump—As first event.

5. Tug-of-War—A standing start required. Men may dig holes with their heels if they so desire.
