FOR THE YEAR ENDING MAY 1869

ONTARIO ANNUAL CONFERENCE.

The Ontario Annual Conference of the M. E. Church in the Dominion of Canada, Province of Ontario, commenced its Seventh Session in Newmarket, York County, May 12th, 1869, at 10 o'clock, a. m.

BISHOP RICHARDSON opened the Conference by reading the 125th and 129th Psalms, and the 6th chapter of the 2nd Epistle of Paul to the Corinthians, and giving out the 702nd Hymn, commencing "Unchangeable, Almighty Lord," after which prayer was offered by the Rev. G. Shepard, G. Jones, and Bishop Smith.

PASTORAL ADDRESS.

Let all the graces of the Spirit find an embodiment in your lives and experience. Our Conference has been one of harmony and sweet counsel. We have labored in all things to advance the Redeemer's Kingdom, and trust that the ministry sent to your respective fields of labor will meet with a kind reception. They will doubtless come to you in the name and fear of the Lord. Co-operate with them; cheer and encourage them in their toils. The blessings of the Triune God rest upon you all, and the labors of this Conference year.

OBITUARIES.

TO THE ONTARIO ANNUAL CONFERENCE IN CONFERENCE ASSEMBLED :

Your Committee on Obituaries beg leave to present the following report :—

It is our painful duty to note the death of our companions in the ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ during the past year, viz., Rev. J. W. Byam and Rev. Geo. S. Thompson ; the former being old and full of years, the latter just rising to his prime and the strength of manhood. Our Lord that is in the midst of the Church thus admonishes us all, old and young, to be ready and watching for His coming.

Rev. J. W. Byam was converted in early life and entered the ministry in connection with the Genessee Conference of the M. E. Church. We next find him a local preacher of the same Church in Canada, and remaining firm in his attachment to the Church of his early choice during the severe ordeal through which it passed in 1832. He was soon after called into active service, and after traveling several circuits with a good degree of acceptability and success, his failing health obliged him to take a superannuated relation, which relation to the Conference he continued to sustain until his death, which took place at the residence of his son, in the village of Manchester, Ontario County, in October, 1868. During his later years his severe bodily affliction prevented his engaging, except to a very limited extent, in any public duties.

His residence since his retirement from active service was chiefly at the pleasant rural settlement of Myrtle, near the village of Brooklin, where his amiable disposition and his patient endurance of his severe affliction endeared him to all who knew him, while his fervent, devotional spirit, and the unmistakable assurance he gave of his deep experience in the things of religion were very profitable to all who had the privilege of meeting with him in the house of God.

His death was sudden, but peaceful ; and his family mourn not as those who have no hope, for he left a bright testimony that to him sudden death was sudden glory.

REV. GEO. S. THOMPSON was born in Tyrone Co., Ireland, April 10th, 1842. His family removed to this country in 1857.

The subject of this obituary was converted and joined the Methodist Episcopal Church in 1862. His superior talents soon attracted the notice of his brethren, and he was admitted on trial in the itinerancy at the Conference held at Georgetown, in 1864, and having faithfully fulfilled his four years' service, he was ordained Elder at the Conference at Meaford, in 1868. His fields were Brooklin, Madoc and Sidney, to the last of which he was appointed at the

Meaford Conference, and went to his work full of health and vigor ; but toward the latter part of September, 1868, he was stricken down by the power of disease, and on the 2nd of October the fatal summons came, in obedience to which his happy spirit took its triumphant flight to the regions on high.

By the removal of Rev. G. S. Thompson we have lost a beloved brother and earnest co-laborer, and the Church an able defender of its institutions.

Bro. Thompson, as a student, was industrious and successful ; as a preacher, he was clear, systematic and forcible. His mind was fearless and independent, and capable of superior attainments. As a Christian, he was correct in his deportment and even in his experience. He died as he lived, in the Lord, and passed triumphantly to his reward. May we each prepare to follow him.

He leaves a widow and one child to mourn his loss. May they be comforted and sustained by our Father above.

Resolved, That this paper be published in the *C. C. Advocate*, and that the Secretary be requested to give such notice of progress from time to time as will secure the desirable end in view.

3RD YEAR.—Review of Bible and Church History; Fletcher's Checks; McIlvaine's Evidences of Christianity; Horne's Introduction (abridged); General History; Upham's Mental Philosophy; A written Essay or Sermon.

4TH YEAR.—Review the whole Course; Stephen's Church Polity; Hallam's Middle Ages; D'Aubigne's History of the Reformation; Townley's Biblical Literature; Claude's Essay on Composition.

 REPORT OF SABBATH SCHOOLS.

Your Committee report as follows:—

We have given the subject all the attention possible; collecting statistics, examining reports and comparing the same with the reports of last year. In doing so we find, that there are still several Circuits without Denominational Schools, and many schools without Bible-classes, which to us is matter a of much regret.

On the whole we are pleased to find that the attention of the Church is becoming so fully aroused to the subject of Sabbath Schools.

We would suggest that information with regard to the working of Bible-classes be communicated through the *Canada Christian Advocate* by those who have succeeded in establishing such classes. Also, recommend that regular District Sabbath-School Unions be held, for the mutual benefit of all interested in this great and good work.

Your Committee would not close this report without mention of our gratitude to God for the blessings brought us and our children by this heaven-born institution.

And we would earnestly urge the members of this Conference to unabated zeal and faithfulness in keeping this matter before our people by precept and example.

REPORT ON THE STATE OF THE CHURCH.

That we as a Church believe our existence and efficiency in this land to be in the Providence of God, and although difficulties and opposition have been our lot, that God who directed has sustained and given us unlooked for prosperity. While attached to our country, our government, and our national institutions we have grown with its growth, and strengthened with its strength. We believe that from our early existence, the liberality of our polity, the soundness and purity of our doctrines, and the unquestionable zeal and devotion of our ministers, we have obtained a firm hold upon the affections and sympathies of the Canadian public. Therefore we are warranted in expecting a continuance of their support, and while we depend on the blessing and co-operation of Almighty God, we may expect to be a powerful means of doing good in the land, in advancing the cause of our Divine Master. Therefore we recommend the following resolutions:—

1. In viewing our cause as a whole we have reason to thank God and take courage.
2. We feel the necessity for continued exertions to maintain our position and continue our march of prosperity and conquest for the kingdom of Christ.
3. In view of this we see the necessity for a fresh dedication of ourselves to God and the interests of our beloved Church. While we feel to rejoice in the advancement of sister churches, we would not lose sight of our individual work as a Church, and feel the importance of loyalty to our own Zion, and in endeavoring to secure the continued attachment and confidence of our membership to our institutions, which are noble and efficient, in doing good in the country and the world.
4. We regret the exodus of so many of our ministers and members from our Church and country, leaving vacancies in our ranks, and fear there are existing causes; for instance, the insufficiency of ministerial support at present and gloomy prospects for the future.
5. Therefore we recommend that more particular attention be paid to our connexional funds. That while we labor for the conversion of sinners and the spiritual upbuilding of the Church,

that we see to the support of her institutions. Therefore having failed to carry out the resolution of last year, recommended by the Committee, in holding District Conventions, composed in part of laymen, we reiterate that resolution, hoping that it may accomplish the desired end.

6. We congratulate the Church on the progress which the Rev. T. Webster has made in writing the history of our church, and would cordially solicit the members of this Conference to comply with his request in his communication to the Conference, respecting items of interest in connection with their lives and work.

7. With reference to the document referred to us by the Niagara Conference, concerning the relation of the Methodist Churches of the country, we recommend that similar action be taken by our Conference, and a committee appointed to learn what they can affecting the subject of Methodistic union, and prepare the way for future action.

REPORT ON TEMPERANCE.

We are also of the opinion that the advocates of this good cause should not place exclusive dependence upon legal measures for the extirpation of drunkenness, but should labor with renewed faith and zeal to bring the truth of God to bear against this monster sin.

Further, in view of the extent to which the use of tobacco has grown, and the multitudes of our youth who are becoming its slaves, we believe that it becomes us as Christians, and especially as Christian ministers, to discountenance its use in the community.

REPORT ON EDUCATION.

That we feel encouraged by the present financial aspects of the College. The funded portion of the debt can be readily met by the annual collections upon the Circuits. The Treasurer and Agent, Rev. J. Wild, announces that he has secured in pledges and cash the ten thousand dollars that constituted the floating debt. The Treasurer of the school in his report shows a very small deficit for the past year, when the number of teachers and lecturers employed and the amount of work done are considered.

The School is represented as being in a prosperous condition. In the winter session there were one hundred students in attendance, the largest number for some years. The University classes are rapidly increasing; young as the institution is, there are already some ten undergraduates and fifteen candidates for matriculation, thus giving promise of prosperity and power; also, several ladies have passed novitiate examinations of Alexandra College. There are eight teachers in the Albert College and Alexandra College, and three besides are laboring without expense to the College Funds. As a proof that the College is conducted with economy, we observe that the whole expenditure for teachers' salaries, fuel, repairs, &c., is but a trifle in excess of the pay of one officer in the Toronto University.

We are gratified to learn that a new and useful Chair has been instituted in our College, (mainly by the liberality of the County Council of the County of Hastings;) viz:—The Chair of Agricultural Chemistry and Mineralogy; as well as to learn that it has been filled with a practical chemist and mineralogist, J. T. Bell, Esq.; and we would as a Conference embrace this opportunity to express our thanks to the Council for its liberality, and the several gentlemen that afford their valuable services at considerable sacrifice to the upbuilding of our College, and through it to the instruction of the youth of our land.

Your Committee is of opinion that much can be done and should be done to raise a fund to aid in the education of candidates for our Ministry; also, that, so soon as the debt of the College is paid, efforts should be made to secure a permanent endowment, which by

2. That we congratulate Bro. Wild upon his success, and heartily rejoice in it; and trust that it may appear good to the College Board and to himself to proceed at once with an endowment scheme, in carrying out which we will aid him as we may have opportunity.

3. That we recommend the enlistment of our women in the work of raising a Ministerial Educational Fund, under an organization similar to the Colborne District Ladies' Educational Aid Society; and to this end we will make effort on our several Charges to excite the interest and direct the energies of our sisters in the Church, and lady friends of the Church, in such a movement.

4. That for our mutual pleasure and profit, we hold a public meeting in the interest of our College, on Saturday, the 15th inst., and that we direct the Committee on Divine Service to make arrangements for such meeting.

The following descriptive reports show the state of a portion of the missions and appropriation fields in connection with this Conference:

COLLINGWOOD

Has 6 appointments, 75 members, and an efficient quarterly board. There have been twenty of an increase during the year. The work is in a prosperous condition, and every thing seems to indicate success in the future.

MUSKOKA

Has 10 appointments, which are scattered over the townships of Morrison, Muskoka, Draper, McCauley, Monck, Watt and Humphrey. The prospects financially and spiritually are encouraging.

UXBRIDGE

Mission contains 4 appointments,—3 in Uxbridge and 1 in Reach. Congregations are good; prospects more encouraging than at the close of last year. The membership is as follows: on trial, 13; full connection, 35; total, 48.

ELMA

Has been blessed with prosperity. Congregations have largely increased, especially in the village of Listowell. Nine have been received on trial.— There are five churches and a membership of 75. On the whole we can thank God and take courage.

OSHAWA
