#### OBITUARIES.

To the Ontario Annual Conference in Conference Assembled:

Your Committee on Obituaries beg leave to present the following

It is our painful duty to note the death of our companions in the ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ during the past year, viz., Rev. J. W. Byam and Rev. Gco. S. Thompson; the former being old and full of years, the latter just rising to his prime and the strength of manhood. Our Lord that is in the midst of the Church thus admonishes us all, old and young, to be ready and watching for His coming.

Rev. J. W. Byam was converted in early life and entered the ministry in connection with the Genessee Conference of the M. E. Church. We next find him a local preacher of the same Church in Canada, and remaining firm in his attachment to the Church of his early choice during the severe ordeal through which it passed in 1832. He was soon after called into active service, and after traveling several circuits with a good degree of acceptability and success, his failing health obliged him to take a superannuated relation, which relation to the Conference he continued to sustain until his death, which took place at the residence of his son, in the village of Manchester, Ontario County, in October, 1868. During his later years his severe bodily affliction prevented his engaging, except to a very limited extent, in any public duties.

His residence since his retirement from active service was chiefly at the pleasant rural settlement of Myrtie, near the village of Brooklin, where his amiable disposition and his patient endurance of his severe affliction endeared him to all who knew him, while his fervent, devotional spirit, and the unmistakable assurance he gave of his deep experience in the things of religion were very profitable to all who had the privilege of meeting with him in the house of God.

His death was sudden, but peaceful; and his family mourn not as those who have no hope, for he left a bright testimony that to him sudden death was sudden glory.

REV. GEO. S. THOMPSON was born in Tyrone Co., Ireland, April 10th, 1842. His family removed to this country in 1857.

The subject of this obituary was converted and joined the Methodist Episcopal Church in 1862. His superior talents soon attracted the notice of his brethren, and he was admitted on trial in the itinerancy at the Conference held at Georgetown, in 1864, and having faithfully fulfilled his four years' service, he was ordained Elder at the Conference at Meaford, in 1868. His fields were Brooklin, Madoc and Sidney, to the last of which he was appointed at the

Meaford Conference, and went to his work full of health and vigor; but toward the latter part of September, 1868, he was stricken down by the power of disease, and on the 2nd of October the fatal summons came, in obedience to which his happy spirit took its triumphant flight to the regions on high.

By the removal of Rev. G. S. Thompson we have lost a beloved brother and earnest co-laborer, and the Church an able defender of

that we see to the support of her institutions. Therefore having failed to carry out the resolution of last year, recommended by the Committee, in holding District Conventions, composed in part of laymen, we reiterate that resolution, hoping that it may accomplish the desired end.

6. We congratulate the Church on the progress which the Rev. T. Webster has made in writing the history of our church, and would cordially solicit the members of this Conference to comply with his request in his communication to the Conference, respecting

items of interest in connection with their lives and work.

7. With reference to the document referred to us by the Niagara Conference, concerning the relation of the Methodist Churches of the country, we recommend that similar action be taken by our Conference, and a committee appointed to learn what they can affecting the subject of Methodistic union, and prepare the way for future action.

#### REPORT ON EDUCATION.

That we feel encouraged by the present financial aspects of the College. The funded portion of the debt can be readily met by the annual collections upon the Circuits. The Treasurer and Agent, Rev. J. Wild, announces that he has secured in pledges and cash the ten thousand dollars that constituted the floating debt. The Treasurer of the school in his report shows a very small deficit for the past year, when the number of teachers and lecturers employed and the amount of work done are considered.

The School is represented as being in a prosperous condition. In the winter session there were one hundred students in attendance, the largest number for some years. The University classes are rapidly increasing; young as the institution is, there are already some ten undergraduates and fifteen candidates for matriculation, thus giving promise of prosperity and power; also, several ladies have passed novitiate examinations of Alexandra College. There are eight teachers in the Albert College and Alexandra College, and three besides are laboring without expense to the College Funds. As a proof that the College is conducted with economy, we observe that the whole expenditure for teachers' salaries, fuel, repairs, &c., is but a trifle in excess of the pay of one officer in the Toronto University.

We are gratified to learn that a new and useful Chair has been instituted in our College, (mainly by the liberality of the County Council of the County of Hastings;) viz:— The Chair of Agricultural Chemistry and Mineralogy; as well as to learn that it has been filled with a practical chemist and mineralogist, J. T. Bell, Esq.; and we would as a Conference embrace this opportunity to express our thanks to the Council for its liberality, and the several gentlemen that afford their valuable services at considerable sacrifice to the upbuilding of our College, and through it to the instruction of the youth of our land.

Your Committee is of opinion that much can be done and should be done to raise a fund to aid in the education of candidates for our Ministry; also, that, so soon as the debt of the College is paid, efforts should be made to secure a permanent endowment, which by its annual increments may meet the annual deficit incidental to the Therefore, Resolved, That we will use our utmost endeavors to obtain liberal annual College Collections, and to forward them promptly and in due season to the Treasurer.

2. That we congratulate Bro. Wild upon his success, and heartily rejoice in it; and trust that it may appear good to the College Board and to himself to proceed at once with an endowment scheme, in carrying out which we will aid him as we may have

opportunity.

3. That we recommend the enlistment of our women in the work of raising a Ministerial Educational Fund, under an organization similar to the Colborne District Ladies' Educational Aid Society; and to this end we will make effort on our several Charges to excite the interest and direct the energies of our sisters in the Church, and lady friends of the Church, in such a movement.

4. That for our mutual pleasure and profit, we hold a public meeting in the interest of our College, on Saturday, the 15th inst., and that we direct the Committee on Divine Service to make ar-

rangements for such meeting.

#### COLLINGWOOD

Has 6 appointments, 75 members, and an efficient quarterly board. There have been twenty of an increase during the year. The work is in a prosperous condition, and every thing seems to indicate success in the future.

#### MUSKOKA

Has 10 appointments, which are scattered over the townships of Morrison, Muskoka, Draper, McCauley, Monck, Watt and Humphrey. The prospects financially and spiritually are encouraging.

#### UXBRIDGE

Mission contains 4 appointments, 3 in Uxbridge and 1 in Reach. Congregations are good; prospects more encouraging than at the close of last year. The membership is as follows: on trial, 13; full connection, 35; total, 48.

#### ELMA

Has been blessed with prosperity. Congregations have largely increased, especially in the village of Listowell. Nine have been received on trial. -There are five churches and a membership of 75. On the whole we can thank God and take courage.

#### OSHAWA

Has 43 members. Paid pastor \$100 during the year. We are working the weekly offerings successfully. The prospects are fair.
