NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF TIMBER LICENSES. CHATHAM, N. B., NOVEMBER 3, 1898. The attention of all holders of Timber Licenses is called to section 11 of the Timber Regulations which reads as follows:—

It has resulted, under the efforts of individuals and provinces, that the Dominion government has, at last, learned and been made to realize that it has no territorial control whatever over any fisheries in Canada. It has however according to Ottawa interpretation, the exclusive right to prescribe regulations or ordinances of any kind respecting the times, manner and methods of taking fish.

BRINE FOR PICKLES.

Spread a white cotton cloth over the cucumbers, and on this put a nicely fitting wooden cover, and the stone of sufficient weight to keep the cucumbers down.

SEEDING DOWN PASTURES.

The seeding of pastures is too difficult a subject to be treated properly in a short article, says a writer. If pasture is wanted at once plow and harrow the ground smooth, and then sow the seed in the following manner: Sow the seed and Timothy, crossing with clover in the spring. The ryegrass will furnish a great deal of pasture in a very short time, and besides it has a tendency to keep down the weeds. If ryegrass is pastured close, until it begins to run up seed stems, it will grow very fine and the cattle will eat it down, so that very few stems will mature seed. My own plan is to sow the seed in the fall, as deeply as to plow the ground with the seed, and then to plow it over with a roller or to stamp it down with a heavy roller. If you have a roller or a stamp, it will be better to use it. In sowing Timothy do not sow too early in the fall. If you sow it too early it will be too young when the winter comes, and will be killed by the frost. If you sow it in the fall, it will be well established by the time the winter comes, and will be able to stand the winter better than if sown in the spring.
