An Act further to amend the Act of Incorporation of the British North American Electric Telegraph Association, to enable the said Association to construct Branch Lines, and to subscribe for Stock in other Electric Telegraph Companies.

HEREAS by an Act passed in the sixteenth year of the Reign of Preamble. Her Majesty, intituled "An Act to amend the Act of Incorpora- 15 V. c. 111. tion of the British North American Electric Telegraph Association," the said Association were authorised to extend their line of Telegraph to the 5 boundary of the United States of America, and to Montreal, and whereas it would be advantageous to construct branch lines connecting with their main line of Telegraph, in order to extend the usefulness thereof; And whereas it would be advantageous to the said Association to hold and possess Stock in other lines of Telegraph within this Province: Be it 10 therefore enacted, &c., as follows,-

I. All, each and every of the provisions and enactments of the Act incorporating the said Company, providing for the construction of the said Branches and line, the purchase of property and the protection and preservation of the said line, and all the provisions therein contained not inconsistent with the 40 present Act, and also the provisions of the said Act amending the same, shall be held and considered and they are hereby made to apply to the branch lines and other works by this Act authorised to be built and constructed, to the same extent as if the said branch lines and other works had been originally authorised by the said Act of Incorporation, and to the pro- 45 prietors or holders of the stock authorised to be raised by this Act.

The said British North American Electric Telegraph Association may hold Stock in and they are hereby authorised to subscribe for and hold stock in any other connecting Telegraph Company incorporated or to be hereafter incorporated under any Act of the Legislature of this Province, or under the Act 50 passed by the Legislature of this Province in the sixteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "An Act to provide by one general Law for the incorporation of Electric Telegraph Companies," or which may hereafter become incorporated under the said last mentioned
