An Act to amend the Municipal Act of Upper Canada.

IN amendment of chapter fifty-four of the Consolidated Statutes for Preamble. Upper Canada; Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. That the following words be added to the seventy-fifth section of Section 75 the said Act, and shall be hereafter read as part thereof, that is to say: amended. 5. Section two hundred and sixty-nine of the said Act is hereby

repealed, and the following section is substituted therefor:-

9. Section three hundred and eighty-five of the said Act is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following proviso, which shall hereafter 30 be read as a part thereof:-

Proviso: as to Recorders holding Division Courts pay.

"Provided always, that where such Recorder consents to hold the Division Courts for the city, without any salary or charge for the performance of such duty, he shall not be disqualified from practising as a without extra barrister, advocate, attorney, solicitor or proctor in any court of Law 35 or Equity, excepting only in such Division Court.

10. The seventy-third section of the said Act is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words :- "No county attorney shall be qualified to be a member of the council of the corporation.

11. The first paragraph of the sixty-sixth section of the said Act is 10 hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof: "The council of every city shall consist of the Mayor, who shall be the head thereof, and one Alderman, and one Councilman for every ward?

Sections 66

12. Sub-section four of section sixty-six, and section sixty-seven of chapter fifty-four of the said Act, are hereby amended by striking out 45 the word "resident" in each.
