GREAT BRITAIN.

LORD J. RUSSELL'S ADDRESS TO THE ELECTORS OF LONDON.

Lord John Russell has issued the following address to the electors of the city of London:

Gentlemen,—More than ten years have elapsed since I was requested by a deputation of electors to relinquish the seat which I then occupied and become a candidate for the city of London.

At that time I was in the enjoyment of the confidence of the electors of Stratford, and I had no reason to fear that I should lose that confidence at the ensuing election.

The proposals which the administration of Lord Melbourne had laid before Parliament bore the character of a market. It was a gradual and a steady advance to the policy of the free trade.

The policy of Sir Robert Peel from 1842 to 1843 was based on the most enlarged principles of commercial freedom.

The articles of corn and sugar were indeed little affected by that policy; but at the end of 1843 Sir Robert Peel proposed in his confidence the total gradual repeal of the duties on sugar.

The late Ministry fulfilled this hope. In 1846 we introduced and carried a bill for the gradual repeal of the differential duties on sugar.

In 1849 we proposed and carried the repeal of the navigation laws; last year we equalized the duties on coffee, and reduced the differential duties on timber.

At the same time, we have not been unmindful of those great interests for which an unjust protection was withdrawn; for instance, in conformity with the suggestions contained in the report of a committee of the House of Lords...
