Le ministère des Affaires extérieures a confirmé aujourd'hui que le gouvernement a prolongé à deux reprises le mandat de M. Barney Danson, Consul général à Boston.

1. La décision originale par laquelle on demandait à M. Danson de terminer son mandat prenant fin le 30 juin 1985 a été transmise à ce dernier par le Très honorable Joe Clark le 15 février 1985 (voir la lettre ci-jointe).
2. Suite à des discussions au Cabinet, le gouvernement a prolongé le mandat de M. Danson jusqu'au 31 décembre 1985 et a transmis cette décision à l'avocat de ce dernier le 7 mai 1985 (voir la lettre ci-jointe).
3. Après de plus amples délibérations au Cabinet, il a été convenu de prolonger sa nomination jusqu'au 30 juin 1986. Cette décision lui a été communiquée par téléphone.

I wish to follow up on our discussions on Ottawa in November and to confirm to you that you should finish your assignment in Boston on June 30, 1985, and return to Canada by that date.

I would ask you to set in train the administrative arrangements for your removal in the normal manner and to submit your travel plans to the Department for approval. I would point out to you that any unused annual leave that you have accumulated, as of June 30, 1985, will be paid to you in cash.

While this letter is perforce administrative in tone, I wish in closing to express the appreciation of the Government for the highly effective and very dignified manner in which you have carried out your responsibilities as Consul General since taking up your duties in Boston last year.
