BILL.

An Act to relieve Steam Tugs from the operation of the Act relating to the Inspection of Steamboats.

HER Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. The several provisions of an Act passed in the session of the Parliament of this Province, held in the twenty-second year of Her Majesty's 5 Reign, now forming the forty-fifth chapter of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the inspection of Steamboats, and for the greater safety of passengers by them," shall be held not to apply to, or include steam tugs employed exclusively in the towing of vessels or rafts, and not engaged in the carriage of passengers.
