LUNENBURG ARGUS WEDNESDAY APRIL 4, 1894 TARIFF CHANGES.

While the Government has been careful to adhere to the principle of protection, it has not failed to reduce its pledges to revise the tariff...

Looking over the more important changes the tariff may be largely considered as in the interest of the farmers. Retaining the full measure of protection on cereals and dairy products...

Another important change is the admission of sugar up to No. 16 Dutch Standard free. This will save not only much vexation to importers but will permit the free importation of certain grades of yellow sugar...

The Budget speech, delivered on Tuesday last bears evidence of the great ability which has always characterized the Finance Minister in the performance of the most arduous task that falls to the lot of a cabinet minister.

His review of the past fifteen years is replete with instruction, while his predictions for the future are full of hope and encouragement to every patriotic Canadian.

To one class of individuals alone was his speech in the least disappointing, and that class is only found on the Opposition benches. For months they had been prophesying that the Government were going to abandon the National Policy, and admit its failure.

By that statement he at once settled the question of the policy of the Government, which will be in the future as in the past, protection to native industries, based on the changing circumstances of trade, production, competition and transportation.

The most important Budget Speech heard in parliament since the inception of the National Policy in 1879 was that which the Minister of Finance delivered yesterday.

Hon. Mr. Foster rose at a quarter of four o'clock amid the applause of a fairly well filled House, to deliver his Budget Speech. He prefaced his memorable address with a promise to endeavor as much as possible his

remarks upon the financial portion of his Budget and disclaimed all intention to make "a speech," so as to do his work in the shortest and most business-like way possible.

The Finance Minister then proceeded to combat the arguments that are advanced against a protective policy by showing that it did not follow that the protective policy was the cause of the present depression...

It is proposed to introduce. All would agree that there could not be a more important question than the arrangement of the tariff and the principles which underlie it.
