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

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

SIR.—I have the honour to report upon 480 samples of Fertilizers, collected throughout Canada by our inspectors in March and April of this year.

The Fertilizers Act, 1909, requires that our inspectors shall obtain for analysis a sample of every fertilizer for sale in the District for which he is appointed. It is believed that the present report meets the above requirement in so far as our inspectors have been able to fulfil it. Many sales of fertilizers are made through agents who merely take orders, and cause delivery to be made direct to the customers from the factory; and it may happen that the particular Brand of fertilizer delivered is not found in stock at any of the warehouses visited by our inspectors.

Section 10 of the Act provides that any purchaser of a fertilizer may secure analysis of the article supplied to him, on payment of a nominal fee of one dollar. A constantly increasing number of considerable purchasers find it worth while to protect themselves under this provision.

The subjoined summary gives the results of analysis:—

It is highly satisfactory to note that there is no evidence of purposeful fraud on the part of manufacturers of fertilizers. The deviations which are observed from guaranteed analysis are all explicable as unintentional mistakes, on the part of the manufacturer, either in weighing or inefficient mixing. This has reference to those samples in which no doubt exists as to specific identity of the sample analysed with the sample as guaranteed.

In cases where the discrepancy is small and where the ingredients are so introduced that deficiency of one component is accompanied by excess of another such that the total value is not less than the guaranteed value, I have used the word *compensated*. In such case, the purchaser receives value, although it may not be in the particular component named in the guaranty. Of course this position could not be taken where the deficiency was at all considerable, since the particular results sought to be obtained by the purchaser might then be endangered, or made impossible.

Much unnecessary trouble in fertilizer inspection results from doubtful identity of the sample analysed with the guaranty furnished. In most cases this is due to altogether unjustifiable carelessness on the part of the vendor. It cannot be too forcibly, impressed upon all who have to do with the sale of fertilizers that every parcel sold must bear a registration number, and that this number legally identifies the brand.

Sometimes the vendor makes a statement to the effect that he thinks or believes that the sample taken by our inspector, represents such and such fertilizer. This leaves the whole matter in uncertainty, and such a statement of probability would fully warrant the inspector as reporting the sample as bearing no registration number, thereby bringing the vendor under the penalties imposed by Section 15 of the Act.

The sale of unregistered fertilizers must be absolutely put a stop to. It deprives the purchaser of all security as to values, and is unfair to the manufacturer who lives up to the requirements of the Act. Excuses offered, such as the loss of tags, the effacement of labels, accidental substitution of wrong numbers cannot be held as valid. The dealer must accept full responsibility for having every parcel of fertilizer sold by him, legally identifiable by having the registration number of the brand attached in legible character.

I would respectfully advise publication of this report as Bulletin No. 291.
