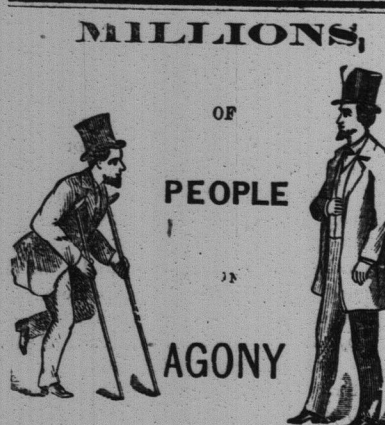

[To the Associated Press.]

MONTREAL, Feb. 3.

An official dispatch has been received at the War Office announcing that Gen. Maronides has succeeded Pampelinas. The Minister of War is also in receipt of intelligence that an engagement took place yesterday at Oricia, between the Royalists and Carlists, in which the latter were defeated. About 1,000 troops are advancing victoriously.

It is reported that the Pope has written a letter to Don Carlos, in which he expresses sympathy for his cause, but advises him to reconsider his determination to continue the war, as the dignity of the Catholic Church in Spain has been vindicated, and the rights of the clergy recognized by King Alfonso.

The Marquis of Hartington has been elected leader of the Liberals.

NEW YORK, Feb. 2.

Gold opened 114 1/2, advanced to 114 3/4 and receded to 114 1/2. Reported it will advance to 120, several causes compelling to make it scarce, especially the premium offered by Germany.

An engine, with 13 persons, collided with a passenger train on the Syracuse Northern Railroad, and most of the persons on the engine were wounded. There was but one injured on the passenger train.

LONDON, Feb. 4.

It is thought that the Bank of England will advance its rate to-day. The billion withdrawal on balance yesterday was £80,000. The City of Paris is negotiating a loan of 250,000,000 francs in London, and gold is flowing to Paris on account of English subscriptions.

FRENCH LEGISLATION.

In the French Assembly the consideration of the Ventoux bill in detail having been completed, a motion was made to bring the bill to a vote on the 11th inst. and to-day was appointed for taking a vote on the third reading. The bill providing for the organization of a Senate will come before the Assembly for a second reading on the 11th inst.

STAMERS WRECKED.

The French steamer Montezuma, from Port au Prince for Havre with a cargo of coffee, went ashore off Inagua and is a total wreck.

The steamship Soudan, from Liverpool for the western coast of Africa, was wrecked near Madeira. The cargo was lost, all hands and the mails saved.

CENTRAL AMERICA.

Disturbances are reported to have occurred in Aspinwall in consequence of the imprisonment of Dr. Piggott, a British subject. A man of war has been ordered from this port to Aspinwall to support the British Consul, who has been assaulted.

NEW YORK, Feb. 4.

A MEXICAN FAILURE.

A well known Mexican merchant has absconded from the City of Mexico leaving liabilities of \$600,000. Several failures of small firms are expected in consequence.
