BOARD OF WORKS BILL.

In the House of Assembly, 6th April, 1857. A Bill to provide for the establishment of a Board of Works.

Ordered, That the further consideration of the above Bill be postponed until the next Session.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to provide for the more efficient management and superintendence of all Lighthouses, Bridges, Wharfs, and other Public Works and Buildings in this Island...

The Board shall appoint a Clerk, at a salary not exceeding twenty per annum, who shall hold office during the pleasure of the Board.

III. The erection, laying out and repair of Lighthouses, Jails, Roads, Bridges, Wharfs, and other Public Works and Buildings...

IV. The Lieutenant Governor or other Administrator of the Government for the time being, in Council, shall and may appoint an Engineer, to visit from time to time the Lighthouses, Buoy and Beacon, Jails, Roads, Bridges, Wharfs, and other Public Works and Buildings...

V. The Board shall be repaid any travelling expenses they may incur in the performance of their duties; and each Member of the Board, not holding any departmental office, shall be entitled to receive a salary of one pound per day for every day's attendance at the sittings of the Board.

VII. The account of all expenditure made and expenses incurred by the Board under the provisions of this Act, shall be kept by the Clerk of the Board, and the amount necessary for that purpose shall be drawn by warrant on the Treasury of the Island...

VIII. The Lieutenant Governor or other Administrator of the Government for the time being, in Council, shall appoint a Member of the Board to be Chairman; and in the absence of such Chairman, the Board may elect a temporary Chairman in his stead.

IX. Not less than three Members of the Board shall form a quorum, for the transaction of business; and the Chairman of the Board for the time being shall have a casting vote in the event of an equality of votes on any matter before the Board.

X. The Engineer to be appointed under this Act shall not, under a penalty of pounds, either directly or indirectly, tender for, make or accept, or derive any profit, benefit or advantage, from any public contract, building or work whatsoever, which may come or be under his superintendence or control.

XI. This Act shall come into force on the first day of January next after the passing thereof, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly, and no longer.

THE OFFICER'S NARRATIVE.

I was conversing with a military gentleman, high a... of his country, one day last week. Knowing him to be a person of true goodness, I asked him what it was that caused him to think about religion at first, and he answered me as follows: "I am now a Christian, of twenty-seven years' standing. I came out to India as a cadet when very young. I was then very careless and wicked. I had a companion as sinful as myself. On our travelling up the country to the military station, we were noticed by an excellent and devoted missionary, who, though still living, is not now in this country. He showed us much kindness, and was at great pains to do us good; but we hardened our hearts against all his counsels, not wishing to give up the pleasures of sin. One morning, we were out together, and having but one gun between us, we agreed to use it time about. My companion used it first, and I then wanted my turn; but he refused to give me the gun until he should have another shot. I felt stung by a sense of injustice; but not wishing to quarrel with him, I turned away my head, as my companion raised the gun to fire a second time.
