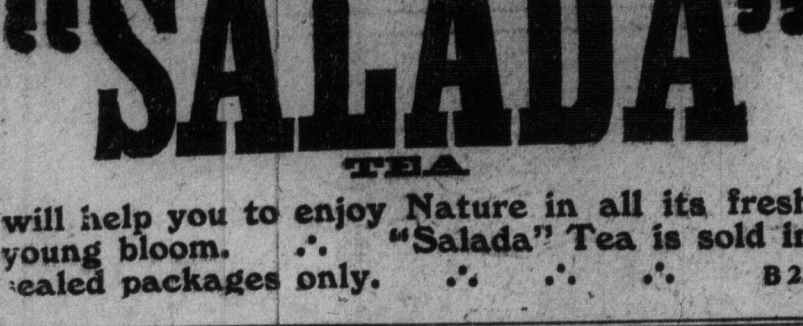

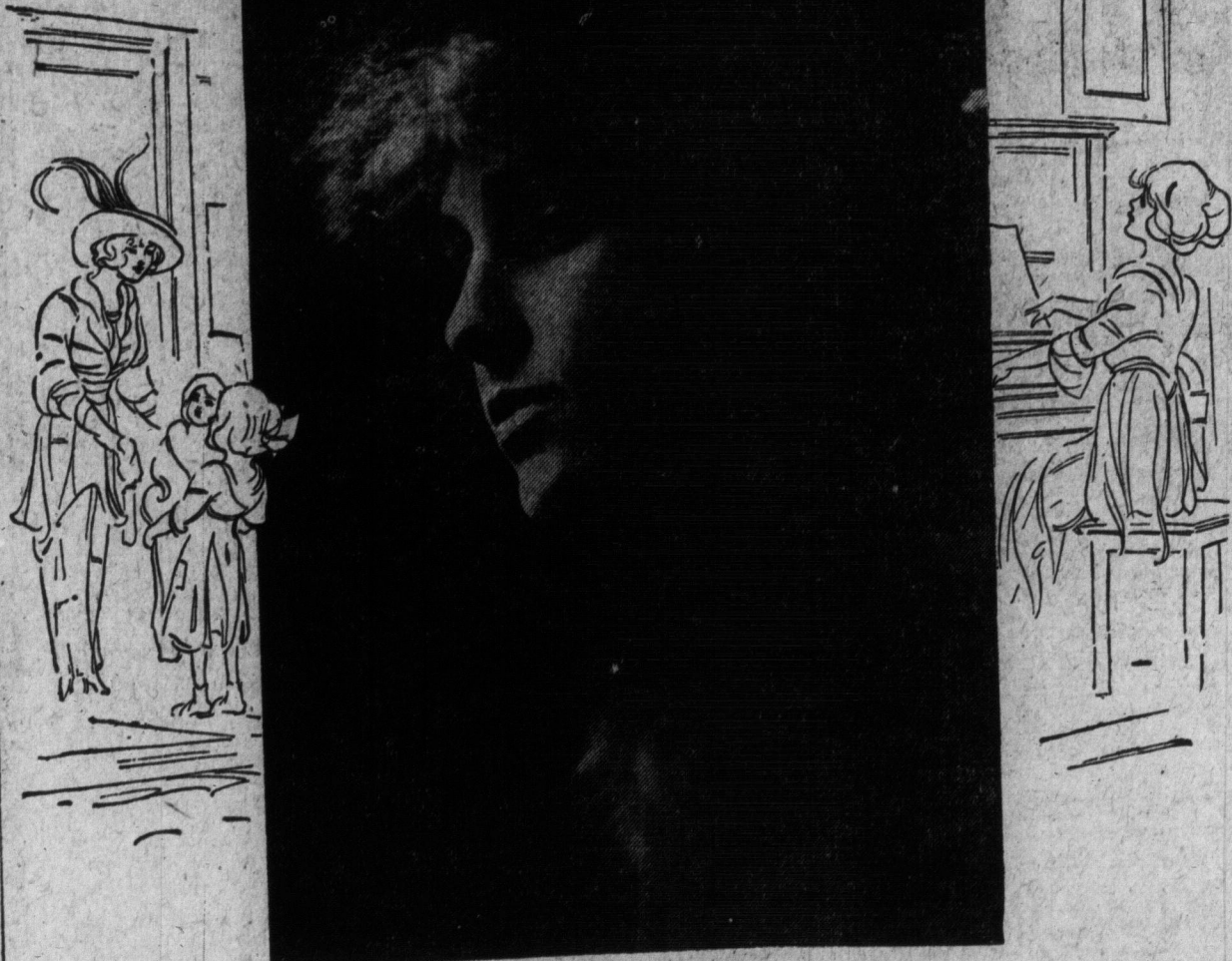

STEAM RESERVE.

The Telegram: Why should 95 per cent of the consumers of electricity pay double the price they need pay in order that 5 per cent of the consumers of electricity may have a guarantee of continuity created by a steam reserve?

This is one of those questions like "When did you leave off beating your wife?" But it takes more than a yes or no answer to settle it satisfactorily.

The Telegram, it is stated by that newspaper, "depends on the hydro for the supply, and has sufficient steam power to keep the presses moving in case of a breakdown in the hydro."

That it is needed in Toronto is clear from the fact that the Toronto Electric Light Company gains and retains 75 per cent of the power business of the city because it has the guarantee of a steam reserve.

It is deplorable to friends of the hydro that the public are not willing to support it in view of the fact that it cuts rates in two.

But the situation has to be faced, and cannot be got away from. Toronto people are not coming to the hydro where a continuous service is a factor in their business.
