

WILL OF THE LATE J. J. LONG

Full Text of the Document That Disposes of Nearly Half a Million of Dollars.

This is the last will and testament of the late John Joseph Long of the Town of Collingwood, in the County of Simcoe, and the Province of Ontario, merchant:

I revoke all former wills by me at any time heretofore made, and I declare this to be my last will and testament.

I appoint my brother, Thomas Long, together with John M. Hopkins, of Collingwood aforesaid, accountant, and William John Sloan of the same place, salesman, to be the executors and trustees of this my will, provided, however, that if either the said Hopkins or the said Sloan at the time of my death is not in the employ of the firm, T. Long & Brother, of which I am now a member, my said brother shall be my executor together with such one of the said parties as shall then be in such employ, and after the death of my said brother and whether the said Hopkins and Sloan or either of them shall be then living and acting as executors or not I appoint the said Corporation of Trustees of this my will to be the sole executor and trustee of this my will in succession to my said brother.

My said brother and the said Hopkins and Sloan as the case may be and if my said brother shall predecease me then I appoint the said Corporation of Trustees, and I direct the said Corporation to employ the said executors and trustee, and I direct the said executors and trustee to assist them in realizing my said estate upon such terms as to remuneration as shall be agreed between them and which terms shall be fair and reasonable.

I give, devise and bequeath all my estate and property of every kind and description and whatsoever situated upon my trust and executor as to the same in trust for the purpose of realizing and getting in the same as soon as practicable after my death, and as to the specific directions herein contained, and of investing and distributing or otherwise more particularly directed.

I direct the payment of all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses and the expenses of proving this my will and of administering this my estate.

I direct the payment of the sum of five thousand dollars to the said John M. Hopkins upon the condition, however, that he be at the time of my death in the employ of the said firm of T. Long & Brother.

I direct the payment to Miss Margaret Boyle of Collingwood aforesaid of the sum of five hundred dollars upon the condition that she at the time of my death is in the employ of the firm of T. Long & Brother.

I direct the payment of one thousand dollars each to Margaret Walsh, Catherine Walsh and Edmund Walsh, and her husband, John Walsh, and the children, Thomas Walsh and Michael Walsh. The lawful children of any such child of my said brother shall be entitled to the share to which such child would have been entitled if living at my death.

To Educate Students. I further direct that within five years after my death the sum of \$25,000 be set apart for my personal estate and be placed in the hands of the said Trust Corporation of Ontario, as a fund for the education of students for the Roman Catholic priesthood in the Archdiocese of Toronto.
