PREFACE.

SINCE the fatal hour of man's apostacy from God by disobedience to the first commandment in the bowers of Paradise, a variety of instrumentalities have been employed to induce him to return to the enjoyment of communion with his God, the companionship of holy intelligences, and the possession of eternal life and happiness in Heaven.

Among the means employed, we find angelic agency, in many instances, in the first ages of the world. Those celestial beings were sent to converse with patriarchs and prophets in olden times and make known the will of God to man. Jehovah himself also often appears and converses familiarly with his chosen servants, the prophets, and sends them forth to propose terms of reconciliation to the nations. As time rolls on, and its fulness comes in, God sends forth his Son "made of a woman, made under the law, that he might redeem them that are under the law." And in order to render the atonement effectual and perfect plans of heaven, and make the triumph of grace complete, the grand commission was given to the apostles to "go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature."

And thus to the Church is committed the glorious work of evangelizing the world, and bringing lost sinners to God. The time, talents, and property of the friends of Christ, and the lovers of humanity, may be employed in extending the dominion of their Saviour, and bringing their companions and fellow-men to glory. May we never weary in so good, so holy, and so glorious a work ! but let us rather apply ourselves with greater zeal and energy to aid in spreading the victory of the Cross to the ends of the earth.

GARAFRAXA.

This field of labor has a membership of 36, with six Sabbath appointments, and has paid \$100 towards the support of the preacher during the past year. At some appointments the congregations are small, and little interest manifested, but, on the whole, the prospects are encouraging.

ST. VINCENT.

This field of labor is situated on the south side of the Georgian Bay, embracing the Townships of St. Vincent, Euphrasia, and part of Collingwood. There are twelve regular appointments and four occasional ones, a membership of 94, two flourishing Sabbath Schools, a good Parsonage, and two Chapels in course of erection. There will be two preachers required for the ensuing year on this field of labor. May the Lord raise up and qualify men, and furnish them with the necessary means, to supply those who are destitute of the word of life!

TEESWATER.

This field of labor is a new work taken up this year, and is composed of the townships of Culross, Turnberry, and parts of Kinloss and Carrick. It has a membership of fifty. In a religious point of view this is an interesting field of labor, and to the agriculturist offers great inducements, the soil being of excellent quality, well timbered, and the country is being settled by an intelligent and industrious population. Altogether the prospects are in every way encouraging.

KINCARDINE.

This charge has enjoyed a good degree of prosperity during the year. It has a membership of 144. A lot has been secured for the site of a chapel and burying-ground on the 7th Line of Kincardine Township, also a lot for a Parsonage. The prospects on the whole are very encouraging.

ORANGEVILLE.

This Circuit and Mission is composed of part of the Townships of Amaranth, Caledon, Garafraxa, and Mono. There are nine appointments, with a membership of 39, with rising prospects. The influence of the M. E. Church is gradually extending, and there is a good degree of encouragement to continue a laborer in this field. A deed of two acres of land has been obtained, on which a chapel is finished, with the exception of pulpit and seats, for which a sum has been collected by subscription nearly or quite sufficient to defray the expenses of completion.

ARTHUR.

This Mission comprises part of the Townships of Arthur, Peel, Nichol, Maryborough, and Luther, and has a membership of 64, with an excellent prospect for the future. There are also two chapels in course of erection, which are expected to be completed during the ensuing

summer. The people are poor, and have suffered greatly the past year from the loss of their crops. But notwithstanding these worldly reverses, a goodly number have been converted to God, and to Him be all the praise.

SANDWICH.

This field of labor is situated on the shores of Lake Erie, and embraces part of the Townships of Mersea, Gosfield, Maidstone, and Colchester. The inhabitants are chiefly Dutch and Irish. There are nine appointments and six classes, with a membership of ninety-seven. The land is of excellent quality. The mission is in a prosperous condition, and the friends are engaged in erecting a house of worship. May the Lord carry on his work!

DURHAM.

This Mission is a very extensive field of labor, embracing six Townships in the Counties of Bruce and Grey. It has a membership of 86. There are twelve regular appointments, with occasional ones. There are four Sabbath Schools, three Temperance Societies, and other institutions for the cultivation of the minds of the young and rising generation. Two sites have been procured for a Chapel and Parsonage, and an effort is being made to erect buildings thereon. The people are poor but industrious; and in consequence of the failure of their crops, they have not been able to contribute much for the support of the gospel during the past year.

STANLEY.

This work is situated on the shores of Lake Huron, in the County of Huron, embracing the Township of Stanley and part of the Township of Hay. It has a membership of 81. There are seven appointments, with six classes, in a prosperous condition. A Chapel is in course of erection. The congregation is large and prospects are cheering for the future—41 having been added to the membership during the year. May the Lord extend the interests of his cause!

DOVER.

This Mission was introduced at the last Annual Conference, and is composed of the Townships of Dover East and Chatham, with parts of Harwich, Howard, Camden, Dawn, and Sombra. There are 13 appointments, 4 classes, and a membership of 72. There are 2 Chapels in course of erection. The Mission is in a thriving condition, and bids fair, at no distant day, to become a self-sustaining Circuit.

ANNUAL REPORT

OF

The Bay of Quinte Conference
MISSIONARY SOCIETY.

In presenting their Annual Report, your Board desire to record their devout acknowledgements to Almighty God for his continued favor to the Missionary enterprise, adapted as it is to call forth the great principles of our Holy Religion, which breathes good will to all mankind.

Such is the nature of pure religious benevolence that it produces a two-fold blessing—the giver is blessed while he gives, and the subject of his benevolence while he receives. While Inspiration declares that “it is *more blessed to give than to receive.*”

The Missionary Society affords not only an appropriate but a most desirable opportunity to test the truth of these sayings. Here every man who gives becomes a co-worker with God in the great work of saving souls, for he “ministers once and again to the necessities” of the “ambassadors of Christ,” while he, sustained in his work by the free-will offerings of the benevolent, proclaims “Christ crucified” as a refuge for the oppressed—a relief to the suffering—a friend to the fainting, dying sinner—and a Saviour to the world.

The great work of evangelizing the world is committed to the Church, and to her the world looks for the *means* of grace, while the “*salvation is of God.*”

“How shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard, and how shall they hear without a preacher, and

how shall they preach except they be sent?" are questions asked by one who well understood the matter, and imply a weighty responsibility upon the Church of God. Purchased by the Saviour's blood, redeemed from sin and iniquity, sanctified by grace Divine, and standing as a city set upon a hill, she should shine forth "fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners."

To aid in accomplishing this work, we, as a branch of the Church of Christ, a few years since organized a Missionary Society, which, from small beginnings, has gradually increased in efficiency till our work is widely spread over the Province, resulting in the conversion of many precious souls from the error of their ways. To God belongs the glory, and to Him shall it be given. Amen.

The sum of \$6494 was expended during the last year within the Province by us, and with results so gratifying as to call upon us again to give—to give liberally, to give freely, to give prayerfully, so that every gift shall be sanctified to God in prayer.

The following extracts from the reports of the Missionaries in their various fields of labor will show more fully the state of the work:—

ELZIVIR.

Rev. N. Howard, who labored on this mission during the last year, says—This Mission embraces portions of the townships of Madoc, Tudor, and Elzivir. There are six appointments, with a kind-hearted people, but the roads are bad. One new class of fifteen members has been formed in Tudor. They are doing well, and are very anxious for the regular means of grace. A chapel is in course of erection in Madoc.

PITTSBURGH.

This Mission is attached to the Kingston charge, and lies on the Rideau Canal. About twenty members are warmly attached to the Church. Hope soon to be able to sustain themselves.

HINCHINBROOK.

Rev. T. Plato says—I found on going to this charge 115 members. I set about my work in good spirits, and my labors were blessed of God in the conversion of about forty souls, by which one new class has been organized, one nearly dead resuscitated, and the Mission generally placed in a healthy state. After the necessary pruning,

three remains 140 in society. The people, although poor, have done nobly in sustaining their preacher. A site for a chapel and burying ground has been purchased.

WOLF ISLAND.

From the isolated position of this Mission, it must long remain Missionary ground. Through the defection of its minister, one year ago, much injury was sustained by the society; but the cloud is passing away, and brighter days are anticipated. The Society numbers forty-four, who have paid their Minister, I. N. D. West, £44, and have also erected a comfortable parsonage for the Minister.

SEYMOUR.

This Mission lies in the rear of Percy Circuit, embracing portions of the townships of West Seymour, Percy, and Asphodel. There are eight appointments and sixty members. A new chapel has been opened during the past year. The people, though poor, have willing minds to support the institutions of the Church.

STORMONT.

This Mission, though once promising, has, we regret to say, through untoward circumstances greatly languished, not having a regular pastor of their own. They have petitioned for a Minister this year, and there is a good prospect of success.

WINCHESTER.

This occupied a portion of Finch, Williamsburgh, Winchester, and Mountain—twelve appointments, 174 members, a chapel and a parsonage nearly free from debt. Preparations are being made for the erection of two chapels more. Paid all other claims besides £91 to the preacher. It is no longer Missionary ground, but comes into the list of regular Circuits.

BONA CHEUR AND EGANVILLE.

Under the labors of Bros. Sparrow and Fulford have enjoyed a good degree of prosperity. They have two chapels, nineteen appointments, and 135 members. In many parts of this work the inhabitants are wholly dependent on the ministrations of our preachers for religious instruction.

WESTMEATH.

Bro. Smith writes from this Mission as follows:—We have eight flourishing appointments, ninety-six members, and two Sabbath Schools, a site secured for a Chapel, with a willing people among whom to labor. This Mission was but lately organized, and will soon become a regular Circuit.

MADAWASKA.

This Mission, on the south side of the Madawaska river and Calabogie Lake, has been occupied but six months—has five appointments

and seven members. The people are poor, but are anxious for the means of grace, and will contribute for the support of the Missionary.

OTTAWA

Lies upon the southern bank of the Ottawa river, about fifty miles below Ottawa City. It includes the Seigniory of Longueil, and the townships of Caledonia, North and South Plantagenet. There are four classes, containing a membership of sixty. Sectarian prejudice is a great obstruction to the prosperity of the cause. Nevertheless, there has been quite a number added to the Church during the past year.

LA CHUTE

Is situated in Eastern Canada, about forty-five miles south-west of the city of Montreal. It embraces the Seigniory of Argenteuil, the Gore, and part of the townships of Chatham and Wentworth. At the commencement of the past year, there were no regular appointments, and but one member. There are now six appointments and thirty-one members. The Missionaries who labored here during the past year, were called to meet with bitter opposition from both the pulpit and the fireside; but the God of Elijah was with them, and enabled them to erect the glorious banners of the dear Redeemer in this remote section of country. Forty-two dollars were contributed upon this Mission, during the past year, towards the support of our Missionary cause. An extensive field here presents itself for Missionary labor. Two men will be required upon this charge, during the coming Conference year.
