## BILL.

An Act to correct an error in the Grand Trunk Arrangements Act, 1862.

**W**HEREAS a clerical error exists in the Grand Trunk Arrangements Act 1862: Therefore, for remedy thereof, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 5   1. In the place and stead of the words "sixty-one" in the fourth line of the eleventh section of The Grand Trunk Arrangements Act, 1862, the words "sixty-two" shall be inserted, and the said section shall be read and construed as though the said words "sixty-two" were and had been at the time of and ever since the passing of the  
10 said Act, inserted in the place and stead of the said words "sixty-one."
- "Sixty-two" substituted for "sixty-one" in fourth line of 11th sec of 25 Vic. c. 56.
