**An Act to amend the sixty-first chapter of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the "Game Laws of Upper Canada"**

**H**ER MAJESTY, &c. :

Preamble.

I. The period fixed in the fifth section of chapter sixty-one of the Consolidated Statutes for Upper Canada, as that within which the hunting, taking or killing of Wild Swan, Goose or Duck, of the kinds known as the Mallard, Grey Duck, Black Duck, Wood Duck, or any of the kinds of Duck known as Teal, is prohibited, is hereby altered and shortened; and hereafter the hunting, taking or killing of the aforesaid Wild Fowl shall be unlawful and be prohibited, only between the first day of May and the first day of August in any year.

The close season for certain kinds of wild fowl altered and shortened in U. C.

II. So much of the fifth section of the said Act as is inconsistent with this Act is hereby repealed.
