Baked Potators for Breakfast.—Take a quart of cold stewed tomatoes, beat in two eggs, 2 tablespoonfuls of bread crumbs, a tablespoonful of chopped parsley, a little more salt and pepper, and bake for 20 minutes in a quick oven.

Satad or Lina Brans.—Put some dima beans, potatoes, and beets (all boiled tender), on ice, and a short time before serving cut the potatees and beets into rather thin slices, add the beans, and dress with old, pepper, salt and vinegar. Garnish with a few water-cresses.

Cannon Fruir.—It is said by some scientist that cane sugar when added to boiling fruit is converted by the heat into grape sugar which has far less sweetening power than cane sugar. Housekeepers are advised therefore to sweeten their fruits not when they are canned, but when they are brought on the table for consumption.
