CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE TWENTIETH SESSION OF THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF UNESCO

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, Don Jamieson, announced today that Ambassador Yvon Beaulne will lead the Canadian Delegation to the 20th General Conference of the United Nations Organization for Education, Science and Culture (UNESCO), to be held in Paris from October 24 to November 28, 1978. Mr. Beaulne is Canada's Permanent Delegate to UNESCO in Paris.

At this biennial General Conference, representatives of 144 Member States will consider the two-year programme plans of UNESCO in education, the exact and natural sciences, social sciences, humanities, culture and communications.

Mr. Napoléon LeBlanc, director of Continuing Education Services at Laval University and former Canadian member of UNESCO's Executive Board, will serve as vice-chairman of the Delegation.


