THAT IRISH CONVENTION. HOLDING FOR THE HONORARY SOCIETY OF THE WEDDING GIDE MONEY.

Michael Davitt Strongly in Its Favor - Thousand Delegates to Be Present. London, Aug. 22 - At a meeting of the Irish National Federation in Dublin, Mr. Michael Davitt, who presided, said he placed a hundred times more hope for Ireland in the work of the forthcoming Irish Convention than fifty sessions in the Imperial Parliament. Between eighty and one hundred delegates from abroad would take part in the convention. The convention would not be packed in the interests of any section. It would not wake up old controversies, but would reinvigorate the National movement, and arouse patriotic energy. The convention, he believed, would secure the fortunes of the Home Rule cause. Before one more year had elapsed there would not be one Irish political prisoner suffering the horrors and indignities of penal servitude in England. Referring to a hundred times more hope for Ireland, he said he was sure that the convention would do more than that.
