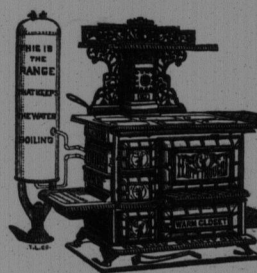

THE SOLE SURVIVOR OF THE HELGA SUCCESSFULLY TAKEN FROM THE BREAKERS.

Nine Bodies Recovered and Buried.—The Helga, a small schooner, was wrecked on the coast of the Miramichi river, near the mouth of the St. John river, on the night of the 28th inst. The vessel was carrying a cargo of lumber, and had on board a crew of eight men and a woman. The only survivor, Alexander Eliason, was rescued by a boat's crew of eight men who entered the breakers at the risk of their lives and after much difficulty they were successful.
