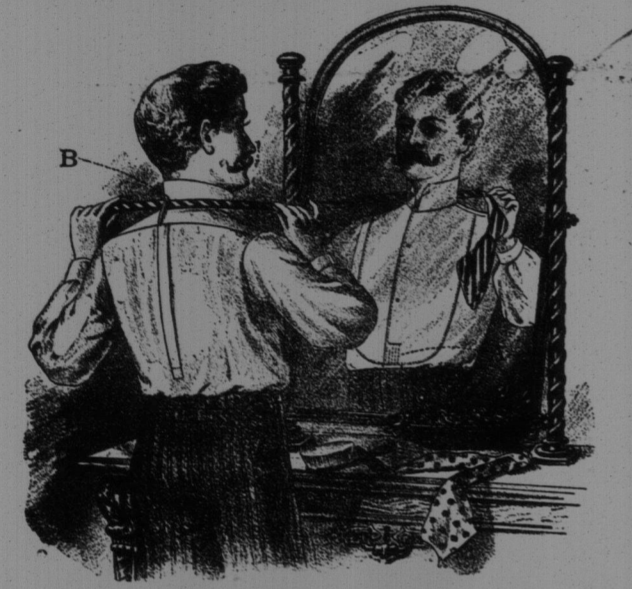

THE DEFEAT OF THE HALIFAX GANG.

The City Debt. The opponents of Mr. Leary's amended plans of harbor improvement pretend they want the city to build its own wharves and say they are willing to spend \$200,000 for wharf construction on the West side. If this plan was carried out, the present year and the next would see an addition to our city debt of \$400,000, as follows:

Special Carleton expenditure, \$100,000; Paving Dock, Mill and Main street, \$100,000; Telegraph wharf improvements, \$20,000; Wharves on West side, \$20,000.

How do the bondholders and the large taxpayers of the city of St. John like the alternative which is proposed to Mr. Leary's scheme? To see the point of view of these gentlemen we are to be added with an addition to our bonded indebtedness of \$400,000 on which we will have to pay interest for ever, until this amount is paid off. Very different is the financial prospect under the Leary scheme. In the first place the city will obtain \$400 a year in rent from Mr. Leary on the harbor front which are not now utilized. In the next place the wharf property will be assessed at a value of \$200,000 and on that value will be paid to the city amounting to some \$2,000 a year.
