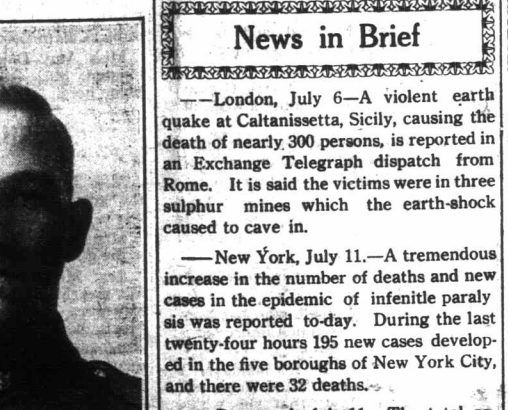

THE pranks played by tradition with the memory of various notable individuals, saintly and otherwise, are unpretentiously the most whimsical amusements both as regards past and present.

The common adage regarding St. Swithin, in every one knows, is to the effect that, as it rains or is fair on St. Swithin's Day, the 15th of July, there will be a continuous track of wet or dry weather for the forty days ensuing.

So far did he carry the latter quality, that, on his death-bed, he requested to be buried, not within the church, but outside in the churchyard, where his corpse might receive the eaves-droppings from the roof, and his grave be trodden by the feet of the passers-by.
