CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The closing days of August finds the white pine market almost as strong as it was one month ago. The constant operation of the mills has necessarily increased the yard stocks, but shipping has been so active that the accumulation at the nulls is not large. Nearly all manufacturers report a larger volume of business than last year. There has been a steady enquiry for all grades of pine, but particularly for the better qualities and to and 12 inch boards, of which the supply is very light. Buyers from the United States have been an important factor in the market this year, and have bought extensively in the Ottawa Valley and Georgian Bay districts. If there is any weakening of prices it pertains exclusively to one or two of the lower grades. The future of pine lumber prices depends very largely upon the policy which maunfacturers follow during the coming winter in respect to their logging operations. If a moderate cut only is made, there is no question that present prices will be maintained. The conditions seem to favor light operations in the woods, as the cost of labor and supplies is exceptionally high. While the outlook for hardwood lumber is fair, the actual demand is less than might reasonably be expected. There is, however, a firm undertone to the market, and it may be that the prospective improvement may come earlier than is anticipated. Lath and shingles continue in light supply, with a good demand, and prices are qui

QUBBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK

Quite a number of vessels have loaded along the St. Lawrence for the United Kingdom. The market for spruce is looking a little more hopeful, and the

opinion is freely expressed that operations in the woods will be curtailed the coming winter, and that next season will witness a marked improvement in spruce prices. The shipments from New Brunswick and Nova Scotia to Great Britain have been light of late, but increased exports have been made to South America and France. The latter country is expected to be # considerable buyer of Canadian lumber within the next few years. Cedar shingles are firmer, practically no extrus being offered at less than \$3.00 on Boston rate of freight. Clears are selling at \$2.70 and second clears at \$2.25.

UNITED STATES

The report presented at the semi-annual meeting of the Mississippi Valley Lumbermen's Association makes the very satisfactory showing that stocks on hand are decreasing each year, while the shipments are showing a corresponding increase. This statement has in a measure dispelled any hope which buyers may have had of obtaining lower prices this fall. The white pine market is exceptionally strong, the large mills having either sold ahead or are meeting, with a demand for the lumber an fast are it is cut. The effect of the transporter factors, namely, the corn care felloge and the strike of steel workers, the prime of and indications are promising for a brist fall trade. The higher grades of lumber are wanted in excess of the supply, while the common and lower grades are moving liberally at good prices. In Chicago there is a pronquinced scarcity of Not 1 and No. 2 12-inch boards as well as ploce stuff, which ranges from \$13.73 to \$14 to cargo lots. Norway pine is but ut firm as white pine. Our Albany and Buffalo, price lists this week show an advance in the higher grades of pine. Reports from these cities tell of a very firm market for uppers and selection Syruce lumber in also hardening, there being a good demand for building material in Nove York. The hardwood trade still lacks the suggestion. is shown by pine, although some dealers give a more satisfactory account of trade and report heavy shipments of basswood, maple and quartered oak. Lath and shingles are not accumulating to any extent, and it is almost certain that the present prices will be sustained throughout the fall.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The course of the British timber market week after week has been so similar as to make a review much of a repetition. The market is still heavy, but with some strong spots. The low price of lumber is stimulating conrumption, and there has

been considerable buying of building materials. At recent auction sales prices have been further depressed, especially floorings, scantlings and the lower grades of lumber generally. At a Lordon sale 3x14-24 inch white pine from Quebec brought only £159s, per standard. The stock, however, was of poor quality. Spruce prices have, not undergone any further advance, but dealers are optimistic that if the full receipts are not too heavy an upward trend will set in. It is announced that Norwegian shippers contemplate carrying over their summer and autumn production until next spring; Waney board pine lins of late shown strength, and Quebec oak of good quality is scarce. Specifications suitable for railway requirements meet with quick sale at firm figures. Red pine is weak, and no improvement can be reported in New Brunswick birch planks.

THE BOSTON MARKET.

The spruce lumber market at Boston continues firm, although business is not particularly active. Nothing in spruce frames is being sold below \$18, and from that ligure up to \$20 and even more is being obtained. Merchantable boards are worth \$15.50 to \$17. and marched ovarus, \$17 to \$17.50. Laths are quiet and steady at \$2.90 to \$2.55 for 1 5-8 in. and \$2.70 for 1 1-2 in.

Enstern cedar shingles are firmer for extras, for the reason that the trade has turned to them, under the fact that they are only about 25c. higher than clears, when the acknowledged difference is 50t. Dealers find that they are getting a good demand for extras, with most of the manufacturers declining to ship them for less than \$3 to Boston. Most of the dealers ask \$3 for extras; clears, \$2.60 to \$2.70; second clear \$2.15 to \$2.25; sap, \$2; extra No. 1, \$1.60 to \$1.75; Washington and British Columbia, 16inch, five butts to 2 inches.

Hardwood lumber continues in only fair request: One inch. whitewood, \$38 to to \$40; thicker, \$26 to \$43; 3% inch, \$30 to \$31; saps, inch, \$25 to \$30; common, \$23 to \$25; quartered oak, \$65 to \$70; fancy, \$50 to \$90; plain oak, \$35 to \$45; ash, \$38 to \$45; cherry, \$90 to \$130; maple, \$30 to \$40; sycamore, quartered to \$130; should be \$130. inch, \$40 to \$50; walnut, \$100 to \$130.

Clapboards are scarce, with the mar-ket largely nominal: Extra spruce, \$30 to \$32, clear, \$28 to \$30, second clear, \$25 to \$27; extra No. 1, \$18 to \$20; pine, extra, \$36 to \$38; clear, \$36 to \$3; second clear, \$28 to \$39.

From the provinces last week five
